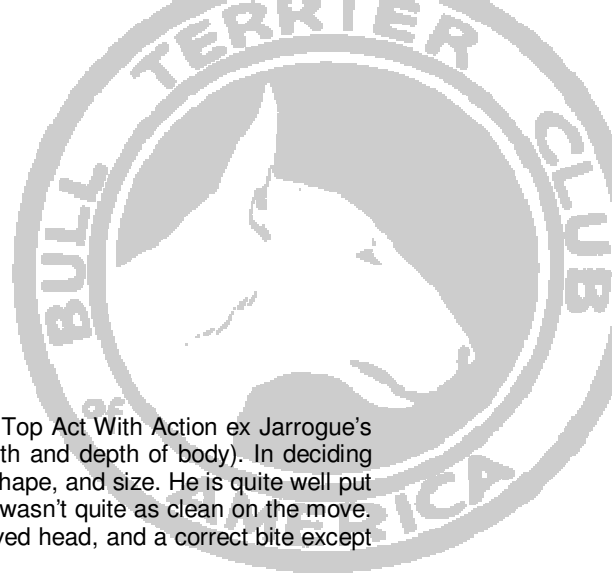

Reserve Winners

Fyhrie and Murphy's **JARROGUE'S DOWNTOWN BROWN** (Ch. Dajan Top Act With Action ex Jarrogue's Jacaranda) Rich brindle and white dog with good density (i.e. good width and depth of body). In deciding between this dog and the WD, I found them to be quite similar in make, shape, and size. He is quite well put together, but did not hold his topline quite as well on the go around, and wasn't quite as clean on the move. He is a large, strong dog with good bone and a powerful moderately curved head, and a correct bite except for one tight canine (another factor in my placements).

Winners Dog, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex

Morris and Poole's **ROCKY TOP'S MIDNIGHT SPECIAL** (Legendary Leon Timar ex Ch. Rocky Top's Midnight Sky) Pale red (almost fawn) and white smut. This is a very large youngster with excellent conformation. He has very good bone, and the width and substance to match his height, i.e. I found him to be well balanced and possessed of a well laid back shoulder and good rear angulation. He is a very good mover, reflecting his sound construction. His head is nicely curved although lacking in width, his bite is absolutely spot on, and he has a pleasing expression.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Salmon's **ZOOZOOZ ABRACADABRA** (Ch. Magor Master Blasterex– Ch. Fortress First Lady) This rich brindle and white was quite competitive but with her mouth faults I could not reward her further. A darker eye and better placed ears would improve her expression. She is a strong bitch perhaps lacking a little elegance, but shows good forechest, strong pasterns, and has a well filled, well turned head. She has substance, pleasing contours, a clean well constructed front, and a good topline and tailset.

Winners Bitch

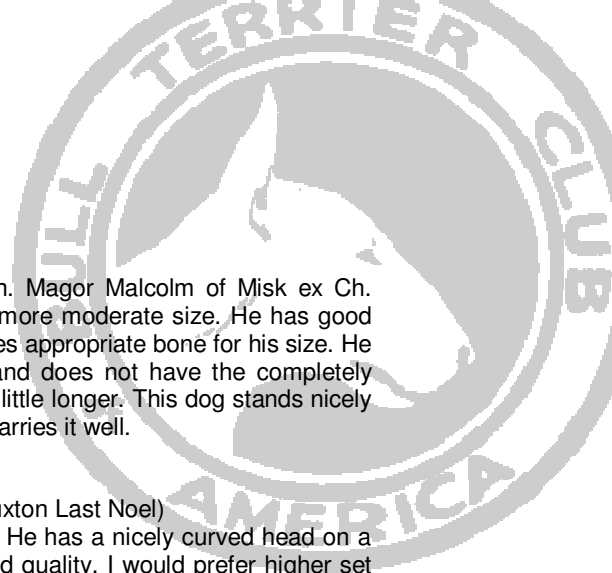
Lewington and Murphy's **JARROGUE'S SCARLET FEVER** (Ch. Dajan Top Act with Action ex Jarrogue's Jacaranda) A very substantial red and white bitch with excellent body volume and a lovely, clean front. She has a tendency to set her rear under herself, which does nothing for her topline. When properly stretched out and moving she was much more pleasing to the eye. Her head is a little small in proportion to her body, but has enough virtue combined with a good bite. She carried the day principally based on her substance and correct front construction which was confirmed on the move.

Best of Variety

Apostol's **CH. SEAWIND SWEET PEA** (Ch. Seawind Citadel O'Brigadoon ex Seawind Champagne Supernova) A top class, smoothly contoured dark brindle and white bitch of good size and substance. She has a well filled, nicely turned head with good expression and neatly set ears. She has strong pasterns and neat feet, a well laid back shoulder, and good width and depth to her body. She is well angulated front and rear, has a good topline, and correct set on of tail. Her movement is sound. An underbite is her only blemish, but easily overlooked in favor of everything else she has to offer.

Select Bitch

Cummins and Toth-Wheeler's **CH DESERT SENTINEL VOM JUBEL** (Ch. Shazam's Bee Delivered ex Ch. Easy Virtue Eve Von Der Alten Veste) A nicely sized bitch of good density. She has good angles in the rear, but is slightly restricted by a shorter upper arm in her front movement. She has a pleasing head but a slight hint of a brow and lighter eyes are distractions. She has a strong, well arched neck, a good topline, and a well set on tail.

Reserve Winners Dog

Overby and Woodruff's **EDELWEN'S DO U BELIEVE IN MAGIC** (Ch. Magor Malcolm of Misk ex Ch. Edelwein's Pandoras Magic Angel) A strongly bodied dog of good, but more moderate size. He has good volume of body with width and depth, is moderately angled, and possesses appropriate bone for his size. He has a keen eye and good expression, but is a little short in muzzle and does not have the completely unbroken profile of the WD. While his neck shows strength, it could be a little longer. This dog stands nicely up on strong pasterns, and although his set on of tail could be lower, he carries it well.

Winners Dog, Best of Opposite Sex

Pew's **BULROARUS TUFF AT THE TOP** (Bulroarus Indiana Jones ex Buxton Last Noel)

Upstanding, statuesque dog who is shapely and well balanced in profile. He has a nicely curved head on a strong, well arched neck. He has a correct bite, and a head of depth and quality. I would prefer higher set ears and a keener eye to give him better expression. A well made dog with clean shoulders, he has good forechest, solid bone for his size, strong pasterns and neat feet. He has a correct set on of tail although he carries it gaily on the move. In the rear, he is a little long in hock, but he is a clean mover in both directions reflecting soundness in construction.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Pizzo's **OASIS PARA BELLUM** (Bilboen Latin Lover ex Ch. Allegro Aire Libre of Oasis) A substantial, somewhat bully type with very good width and depth of chest. She has a clean front, but a little slackness in pastern. She has a lovely expression and good ears, but lacks a little in strength of muzzle and downface. Her tailset and carriage could both be lower.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best of Variety

Garcia's **ELVROC CLEAR THE WAY** (Ch. Silver Bullet The Joker At Javarke ex Javarke Crazy Clover at Elvroc) Statuesque, dalmatian style of bitch combining good bone for her size with very good overall proportions. She has pleasing curves in profile starting from a smoothly contoured head, a strong well arched neck of good length, a good topline and tailset, and good tail carriage. She has excellent under eye fill, a correct bite, and lovely expression. While I'd like to see more forechest, her shoulders are well set and she moves cleanly both at front and in the rear. On the debit side, she could have more depth to the muzzle, neater feet, and more width of body. Having checked with the steward on her age, I gave her some latitude on the latter, and concentrated on her other positive virtues in choosing her for BOV.

Select Bitch

Farrington, Aron and Foote's **CH. DESLYNN'S MOONDANCE AT DONNYBROOK** (Aricon Easy On The Eye ex Deslynn's Dark Lilly At Donnybrook) This is a well put together bitch of good substance and bone for her size. Although her high tail set and carriage tends to spoil the outline of an otherwise lovely body, she stands nicely up on strong pasterns and moves well both coming and going. She has a strong neck that ideally could have a little more length. She combines a lovely expression with a correct bite. She has a pleasing head in profile, but the slight flatness in the middle combined with the suggestion of a brow gave preference in the final placement to the WB.
