Reserve Winners Dog

Woodman's **SKYLINE DEFIES DAZLIN** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance ROM ex Ch. Skyline Sticks N' Stones) Attractive red and white dog who is more up on leg and longer in back than the WD. He has very nice lines with good length of neck and a lovely head profile. He has a pleasing head overall with nice expression. Good width and depth of muzzle, and a correct bite. He has neat feet and strong pasterns, but a slightly short upper arm inhibits his front movement. Moves correctly in the rear.

Winners Dog and Best Of Opposite Sex

Midulla, Myall & Cambell-Hegg's **ICENI WINDWARD POINT** (Ch. Bulleniums Big Bazooka ex Ch. Icen Point Taken) This nicely marked brindle and white dog exemplifies the cobby, compact type we rarely seem to see today. He is short backed, well put together, muscular and of good proportionate width. He has a strong head with an ever so gently curved profile and a good bite. I liked this dog's density, sound construction, and correct athletic movement. He has good bone for his size, and neat feet. A little more reach of neck and downface would complete this top quality picture.

Reserve Winners Bitch

McConnell & Baval's **OLD ENGLAND'S DUCHESS OF SILVER** (Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke ex Ch. Old England's Lady Elizabeth) This is a very promising, statuesque brindle and white youngster. She does not have her final proportions yet, mainly lacking width of body, and seemingly a bit long in proportion, but there is a lot to like. Her head is nicely filled, with a lovely profile and good depth to the muzzle. She has length and strength in her neck, and good angles at both ends. Her topline is a bit flat, but she has a good set on of tail and correct carriage. Movement is good, but youthfully loose in front.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best of Variety

Hopkins' **TERJOS CELTIC BROKEN ARROW** (Megaville's Sardonicus ex Javarke Calico of Terjos) A solid brindle with very little white (markings only on the toes, and under the neck). With her sweeping, unbroken head profile and reachy, strong and curved neck, and correct topline, she presents a lovely picture in profile. She is strongly built and muscular, yet retains her femininity, combining balance with smooth curves. She has engaging expression, and a level bite, but could have more width to her muzzle. A vivacious showgirl, she was beautifully presented and in fine condition. With her good looks, excellent type, and correct movement, she was a very worthy winner.

Reserve Winners Dog

Azeur & Keiling's **BULLY MANOR'S HUNTER** (Ch. Miramax Maximillion ex Ch. Bullicor Quist Soda) Middle-of-the-road type with a brindle left eye patch. He has some pleasing elements including a correct topline, tail set and carriage. He has very strong quarters, with good turn of stifle. I would like more layback of shoulder, as this would make him look longer in neck and shorter in back. His head, while pleasantly turned and filled has a slightly broken profile (brow) which detracts from the overall impact. Additionally, he lost out to the WD in the areas of substance and bone.

Winners Dog

Smith's **FIRST CONTACT WISH ON A STAR** (Ch. Boromir Quicksilver ex First Contact Limited Edition) Upstanding, well built, athletic dog with brindle ears. He is balanced at both ends with lovely forechest and good layback of shoulder at the front, and good turn of stifle in the rear. His head has width throughout, nice expression, and a correct bite. In profile it is more curved at top than in the muzzle. He has strong pasterns, neat feet, and adequate bone for his size. He has good proportion, with a strongly muscled neck and good width of body. Although his tail sets on a little high it is more of a superficial fault, as his construction appears to be correct as reflected in sound movement.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Greaney's **GRISSEBASSE TYRANNOUS ANGEL** (Trick or Treat Armageddon ex Quest Heritage de Grissebasse) A pleasing, terrier type bitch carrying brindle on the right ear. She has a lovely, feminine head with moderate downface, neat ears, and lovely expression although there is a hint of a brow in profile. In proportion, she is a little longer than the WB. As befits her type, she could have a little more bone to balance her body. On the positive side, she has a correct topline, with correctly set on tail and good carriage.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Maddox's **QUICKSILVER STELLAR SENSATION** (Ch Stellar Quicksilver Showshocker ex Ch Quicksilver American Idol) Miss personality! This one is full of herself, in the true, energetic bully fashion. She is a substantial bitch with great volume in her torso. Her head is strong, with width, depth, fill and turn and has a keen expression accented by neat ears. Carries brindle in her right ear. While slightly short, her neck is strong and turned. A croup that has too much slope betrays her topline on the move, and consequently she moves a bit 'under herself' at the rear. She is balanced, though not over angled, at front and rear and her movement is therefore acceptable. With her body size, a tad more bone would make the picture more balanced.

Best of Opposite Sex

Landry & Baval's **CH OLD ENGLAND'S WHITE KNIGHT** (Ch. Rocky Top's Doc Holliday ex Ch. Old England's Perfect Balance) An upstanding dog of good bone and substance. His body is well balanced, with good angles reflecting a well laidback shoulder and good forechest, and he combines neat feet and strong pasterns on such a big dog. Having such a strong, reachy neck, I felt he could do with a bit more length in the head and more underjaw for a completely balanced picture. His head is more curved at the top than at the muzzle (similar to Eyeopener). On the debit side also, his bite is off (under, with one tight canine), and his tail is set on and carried, a little high, somewhat disturbing the overall look. Nevertheless, he moves well, as befits his basically sound construction.

Best of Variety

Stafford & Poole's **ROCKY TOP'S SIMPLY IRRESISTIBLE** (Alecto Cool Barracuda of Kilacabar ex Ch. Rocky Top's Honey N' Roses) A top quality bitch combining soundness with much breed virtue. She carries tri-color as evidenced by her left eye patch. She has very clean lines, muscular yet elegant, and combines a body of good width and depth with a lovely topline, correct tailset and carriage. She is balanced, with good angles at both ends and has a particularly well turned and powerful rear, on which she moves exceptionally well. Her front construction combines a well laid back shoulder, good forechest and straight, true legs with strong pasterns and neat feet, all of which is reflected in correct front movement. Her pleasing picture from the side is accented by her strong, reachy and curved neck, and unbroken profile. Her head has length and a perfect bite, but on the downside, has some pink on the nose, and an eye that could be keener.
