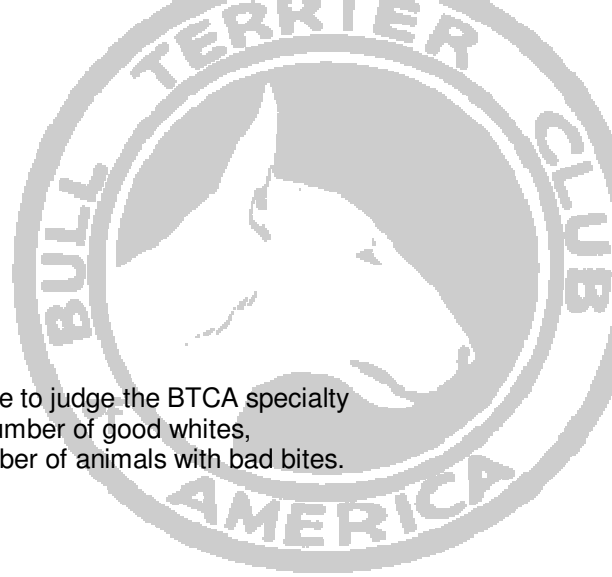


Bull Terrier Club of America

COLORED BULL TERRIERS: 7-4-(2-1)

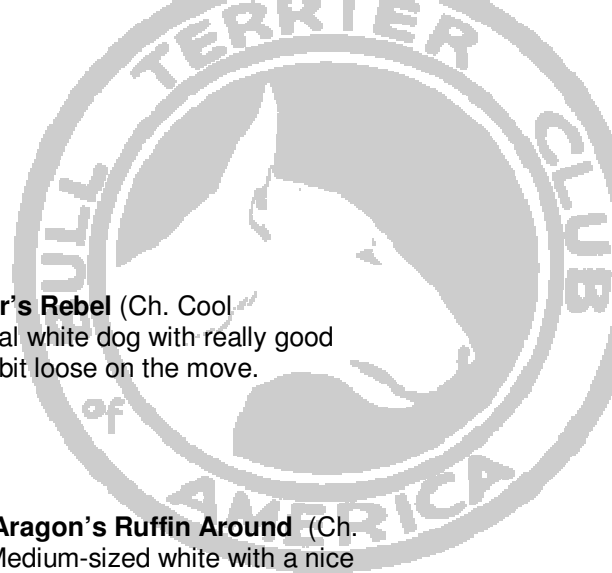
WINNERS DOG & BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: Huey's **Crestmonts Savoir Faire** (Ch. Cool Conquistador at Cross Garley x Ch. Crestmonts Chances R Bestuvall). Brindle and white. Upstanding dog with nice bone and short back. Strong head with wonderful depth of muzzle and dramatic turn. Good length of neck and tiny, dark eye. Mouth off.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Nichols & Frascone's **Sinabar on a Crazy Train** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic x Sinabar LaVita E Bella) A substantial youngster with a ton of bone and outgoing personality. Well packed head with a nice profile. Mouth just off. Still a bit loose, while on the move.

WINNERS BITCH & BEST OF WINNERS, Selk, Everett, Greco and Bankus's **Aragon's Ruffin it Honeytree** (Ch. Crescent Silmaril Shadofax x Ch. Horizon's Harmony of Aragon) Red and white. Pleasant head, filled and well turned. Mouth correct. She is a really good mover, both coming and going. Would like to see her "body-up" which she should do as she matures.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Hatten & Frascone's **Sinabar Lyrical Passion** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic x Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) Brindle and white. Pleasing head with fill and profile. Correct mouth. Decent movement both ways. Would like a little better topline.

BEST OF VARIETY: Woods & Frascone's **GCh. Sinabar Lady LaBella at Bulloved** (Ch. Bestuvall Razor Redicut x Starstruck Peekaboo) Brindle and white. Not a big bitch, but with enough substance for her size. Strong head, which is filled and turned with good length. Scissors bite. Nice long neck with plenty of fore-chest. Moved well coming and going. Well presented by her handler.



WHITE BULL TERRIERS: 6-10-(4-2)

WINNERS DOG: Rothermund & Wright's **Glentom Conquistador's Rebel** (Ch. Cool Conquistador at Crossgarly x Ch. Glentom Mint Julep) A substantial white dog with really good bone. Well filled head. Dark well placed eye. Correct bite. Still a bit loose on the move.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Bentall, Doss, Greco and Bankus's **Aragon's Ruffin Around** (Ch. Crescent Silmaril Shadofax x Ch. Horizon's Harmony of Aragon) Medium-sized white with a nice short back. Nice head, which is filled and well turned. Mouth just off. Would like a bit more spring of rib, which should come as he matures. Moved well both coming and going.

WINNERS BITCH, BEST OF WINNERS, BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX, & BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST OF BREED Schuur's **Sarajeni Pretty White Satin** (Ch. Pretty Boy Floyd the Joker & Sarajeni Paris) A substantial white bitch with a very strong head. She has great depth of muzzle with a long foreface, which is well packed under her eyes. She has a perfect mouth with every tooth in place. Ample bone. Moved well coming and going. To be critical, she is a bit long cast.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Nichols & Frascone's **Sinabar and Love Like Crazy** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic x Sinabar LaVita E Bella) A well balanced bitch with a really nice head which is filled and turned. Dark eye, wicked expression, and a correct bite. A youngster with lots of promise.

BEST OF VARIETY & BEST OF BREED: Altmann's **CH Action Dream Come True** (CH Old Forge Tug Mcgraw at Chevalier x CH Action Moonbeam Dream) A medium sized dog with good bone and substance for size. Moves well coming and going. Terrific expression. His head has good length, width and fill. Correct bite. He is a typey dog without significant faults.
