I would like to thank the club for inviting me to judge your show. It was a great entry with good depth of quality. There were a number of close decisions which ultimately hinged on expression, where, for me, varminty is a harbinger for breed type.

COLORED

WD, BOW- Davis and Holmes' D Bar Iron Mike Sherlock (Ch. Beaujest Boogity Times Three ex Ch. D Bar Sweet Lou) A substantial brindle and white guy with some dominant virtues. He has a wide, strong head with good length and power...perhaps a bit more turn and finish would complete it. Mouth slightly off. Good expression. Great bone and substance. Good spring of rib. A tad upright in shoulder and long in back. Moved a bit like a bull in a china shop but enough to note that when he settles he moves ok in front, better in rear. His masculine virtues were not to be denied in today's company.

RWD- Lara's Ch. Rockwell "Boom Boom" at Hubert's MX (Ch. UK Stockleyview Dark Destiny ex MX- Ch. Belle Blonde of Braveheart) An elegant tri, very different from the WD. He has a nice, long head with good turn and fill...could wish for more width and power. Good front and shoulder. Good topline. Would like a bit more bone. Moved well both ways. A quality exhibit.

WB- Cash, Wright and Schneider's Glentom Lebeouf's Countess Singing Cloud (Ch. Dazlin Defiance ex Ch. Glentom Pearljam De Mint) A substantial red and white girl with some brood bitch virtues. She has a wide, strong head with reasonable fill that could use a bit more turn and finish. Better ear set would help. Good bone and substance. Short back. Moved well both ways. One for the whelping box.

RWB- Langer's Serendipity Bella Luna (Ch. Victoria's Grimaldi Windfall ex Serendipity American Gothic) A brindle and white. She has a nice long head that could use a bit more fill. Good front and shoulder. Close decision for WB.

BOS and BOS to BOB-Croucher's Ch. Acie's Jack Sparrow (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty ex Ch. Acie's One More Look) A typy brindle and white who catches your eye. He has a good head with strength and fill. Good expression. Slightly upright in shoulder. Good bone. Short back with a good rear. Moved a bit bully in front, well in rear. He is a typy package for which he was rewarded.

BOV and BOB-Hopkins' Ch. Terjo's Celtic Broken Arrow (Ch. Megavilles Sardonicus ex Javarke Calico of Terjos). A lovely solid brindle with very pleasing lines. She has a good head with length, turn and fill. Good expression. Good mouth. Good front and shoulder. Nice long neck leading to a good topline. Would like a bit more bone,

substance and spring of rib. Moved well both ways. A lovely combination of type with style.

## WHITE

WD, BOW- Schneider and Wright's Lebeouf Beaucoup Blanc of Glentom (Ch. Dazlin Defiance ex Ch. Glentom PearlJam DeMint) A typy young dog that I really liked. He has a good head with length, turn and fill... a bit more strength at the end of the muzzle would complete it. Good expression. Mouth off. Good bone. Good front and shoulder. Short back. Moved well. He is a young dog and seemed a bit tired in the evening round. He pushed for BOV and in six months the tables could be turned.

RWD-Adams and Smith's Magor Mr. Cool (Alecto Kool Barracuda of Kilacabar ex Ch. Magor Steel Magnolia of Misk) Very different from WD, he is upstanding with good make and shape. His head is perfectly acceptable with strength and length...more finish and fill would complete it. Mouth is off. Better eye set would give a more varminty presentation. Good front, shoulder and topline. Acceptable bone. Could wish for a bit shorter back. Moved well.

WB- Breidenstein's Acie's Norma Jean (Acie's Fly N First Class ex Acie's Dress to Thrill) She has a nice head with good length and turn. Good front and shoulder. Would like a bit more bone and spring of rib. Moved better in front than rear.

RWB- Croucher's Acie's Linen and Lace (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty ex Acie's Dress to Thrill). A cobby package. She has a nice wide head that could use a bit more turn and finish. Front and shoulder not her fortune, affecting her topline. Good bone and a nice short back. Moved a bit wide in front, well in rear.

BOS-Azeur's Ch. Bully Manor's Pure Pandemonium (Ch. Miramax Maximillion ex Bullovers Bailey Cream) A lovely package. She has a nice head with good turn and fill. Good expression. Good front and shoulder. Would like a bit more bone and substance. Moved well. Her head quality and typiness did it for her.

BOV- Azeur's Ch. Bully Manor's Centurion (Ch. Miramax Maximillion ex Bullovers Bailey Cream). Fully mature, he establishes a presence in the ring. Nice turned head with good finish. Good length of neck set on well-laid shoulders. Good topline, especially on go-round. Would like a shorter back and a bit more bone. At one with his handler, today was his day.
