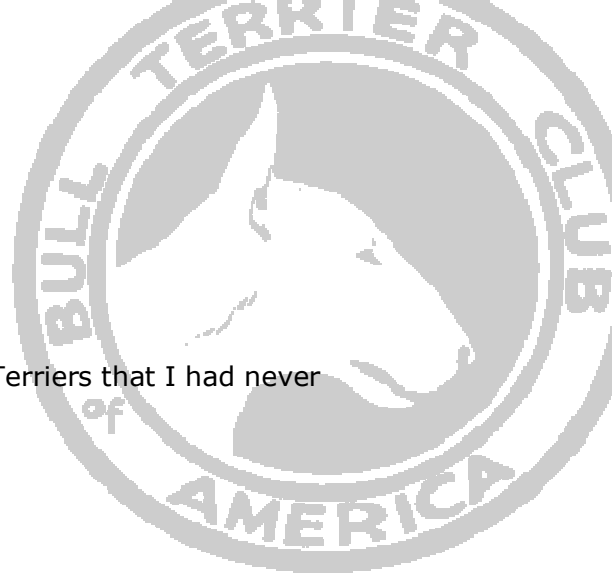


THE BARBARY COAST BULL TERRIER CLUB

It was a pleasure to judge so many new, promising Bull Terriers that I had never seen before. The over-all quality had depth.

Several decisions were very close.

COLORED:

Reserve Winners Dog:

Olage, Robertson & Lowden's **WALKIN TALL TRIUMPH O'BRIGDADOON** (Ch. Seawind Citadel O'Brigadoon ex Ch. Brigadoon Fire Bird). A puppy with a nice eye and expression, good angles front & rear. Nice, free movement. Great bone with tight feet.

Winners Dog, Best of Winners and Best Opposite Sex:

Dykema & Coy's **BESTUVAL SHO IS HOT** (Ch. Quicksilver Showstopper ex Bestuvall Believes She's Hot). Just over a year old, this youngster shows great promise. Lovely over-all balance with a lot of class. Good depth of head with nice turn. Good angles front & rear which allows for good side movement. A wonderful showman.

Reserve Winners Bitch:

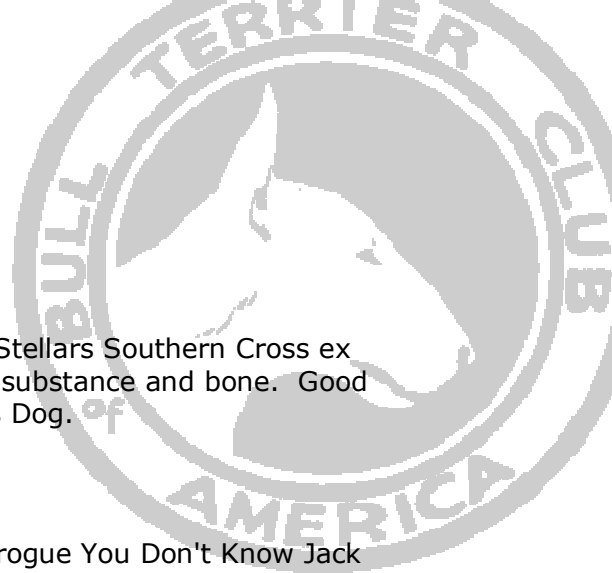
Dykema's **BESTUVAL TOO HOT TO STOP** (Same as that of Winners Dog). Good turn with a wonderful expression. Nice, easy mover owing to proper angles. Great bone and feet.

Winners Bitch:

Goldberg, Ebey & Berez's **ACTION BA SW RED LIGHT ROXANNE** (Ch. Lonestar Whole Lota of Hoopla ex Ch. Action Quigby Wreaking Havoc). A bitch with a great deal of class and marvelous attitude. Very nice eye and expression. Very well-made neck fits well into shoulder. Good set-on of tail because of proper hind assembly. Could use a bit more bone for the size of her frame.

Best of Variety:

Vincent & Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER LICKITY SPLIT** (Ch. Mozie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle). This lovely Brindle bitch is a very nice over-all balanced specimen without exaggeration in any area. All the pieces match and flow together admirably from her nose to the set-on of her tail. She stands on beautiful feet. Her overall picture is very pleasing to the eye.



WHITE:

Reserve Winners Dog:

Shaw & Dykema's **BESTUVALL THE DUPLICATOR** (Ch. Stellars Southern Cross ex Bestuvall Color Copy N Action). Over-all a dog with good substance and bone. Good eye but could use more fill. A bit longer than the Winners Dog.

Winners Dog, Best of Winners & Best of Variety:

Mahadevan & Murphy's **JARROGUE'S JACKSON** (Ch. Jarroque You Don't Know Jack ex Jarroque's Okey Dokey). This is a powerfully strong dog that admirably combines Bull & Terrier Type. His head has good depth & fill with turn. He has a splendid balance of angles which allows for fluid, free movement. He just needs more polish in his condition and presentation.

Reserve Winners Bitch:

Crabtree's **ROCK-IT NIGHTS IN WHITE SATIN** (Ch. Del-Mar's Hidden Treasure ex Ch. Rock-It Brown Sugar). A lovely, over-all typey bitch with a very pleasing eye and expression. Good angles and good feet. She is a bit longer in body than the Winners Bitch.

Winner's Bitch and Best of Opposite Sex

Turk & Gothan's **BULLARD'S SNOW STORM.** (Ch. Bullards Boaz-ex Ch. Jael's Hammer of Bullards). A bitch with strong type and wonderful all-over balance. She has good turn and plenty of fill. Her easy, flexible movement comes from proper angles.

Best of Variety

Winners Dog.

Special mention has to go to **Ch. STONEWALL'S HOT ACTION HOLIDAY.** This super bitch, a litter sister to the colored Winners Bitch, is a of top quality in type, balance, structure, and head. On the day, she was not not showing any proper terrier spirit.

Finally, I would like to thank the Club, the exhibitors, and most of all the breeders for making my assignment so enjoyable. It was a memorable occasion with so many wonderful Bull Terriers.
