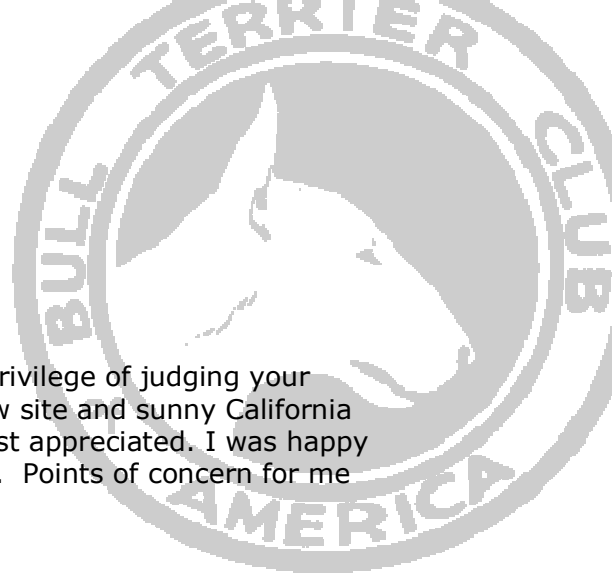


Barbary Coast Bull Terrier Club

Reserve Winners Dog

Smiths & Harlamoff's **SOQUEL MILLENIUM THE BUCCANEER** (Ch. Brummagen Spectacular Bid ex Ch. Brigadoon's All Black Soquel) Very well made and short bodied dog with ample bone, solid topline and excellent rear quarters. Profile smooth and unbroken. Adequate fill. Deep under jaw. Mouth incorrect. Covered ground with drive.

Winners Dog and Best Of Winners

Marcus, Robertson & Lowden's **WALKIN TALL SHARPER IMAGE** (Ch. Seawind Citadel O'Brigadoon ex Ch. Brigadoon Fire Bird) Masculine, well boned, compact and short coupled fawn smut dog. Athletically made with good muscling and nice angulation fore and aft. Short, firm topline. Deep underline and good substance throughout. Head has gentle profile with adequate finish, fill and width. Ear placement and carriage correct. Eye could be smaller. Expression very good. Slight mouth fault. Covered ground efficiently and with verve.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Gothan's **BULLARDS PATRISHA AMELIA** (Ch. Bullards Boaz ex Ch. Jael's Hammer Of Bullards) High quality black brindle bitch from the BBE class. Head nicely filled with good profile although a smaller eye would improve the picture. Good bite. Adequate bone. Well muscled and proportioned save a longish loin. Quarters are soundly made and moved out nicely.

Winners Bitch

Waynee & Harlamoff's **SOQUEL MILLENIUM BLACK ORCHID** (Ch. Brummagen Spectacular Bid ex Ch. Brigadoon's All Black Soquel) Feminine, corky brindle and white from a very strong BBE class. Lovely curving profile, smoothly filled and plenty of underjaw. Proper eye shape, size and placement. Strong, short topline with correct underline. Good bone quality and overall substance. Decent shoulders place elbows well under body. Her rear quarters are excellent in make and muscle especially the sweep of stifle. Consequently she moved out well coming and going

Best of Opposite Sex

Robertson & Alexander & Lowden's **CH. WALKIN TALL DARK AND HANDSOME** (Ch. Seawind Citadel O'Brigadoon ex Ch. Brigadoon Fire Bird) Big masculine solid brindle dog with filled and packed football head. Nice wide muzzle. Tiny eye and super expression. Very good bone quality, depth of chest and overall substance. Quarters are strongly made and moderate in angulation. Long in loin. Covered ground well at both ends.

Best Of Variety

Vincent & Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER LICKITY SPLIT** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) The total Bull Terrier package in balance, type, soundness and attitude. She is athletic in make, shape and movement. Wonderful curving profile. Correct bite. Long head is well filled, eye correct in shape and size, and muzzle ends in roman finish. Tidy ears. Keen expression. Very strong topline from beginning to end. Neck set on good as is tail carriage. Quarters are adequately angulated with hocks let down. Strong feet. She is feminine yet exudes power and capability.

Reserve Winners Dog

Ruppel & Zappettini & Zarubin's **QUICKSILVER MAXIMUS** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) Masculine and well made dog with good profile, adequate width, fill and finish. Good expression with small, dark well placed eyes. Tidy ears. Good neck, topline and underline. Short coupled body with deep chest and good rib spring. Well muscled. Covered ground adequately.

Winners Dog, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex

West's & Hegg's **ICENI WESTPOINT** (Ch. Bullenium Big Bazooka ex Ch. Icen Point Taken) Handsome solid, symmetrical and balanced dog with very pleasing head. Nice sweep of profile, fill, finish and width. Eye placement and expression very good. Underjaw deep. Neck joins body smoothly. Good front construction and rear angulation. Plenty of bone, overall substance and muscle throughout. Short, firm topline. Proper tail set and carriage. Moved efficiently at both ends.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Utt & Gothan's **BULLARDS N ARDRYS HOT ICE** (Ch. Ardry's Desert Heat ex Ch. Jael's Hammer of Bullards) Feminine, high stationed bitch with lovely profile, finish and expression. Good bite. Skin fits tightly on her frame. Moderate bone and substance. Needs more shoulder layback and a shorter loin. Good rear movement. She lost to the winner on lesser volume.

Winners Bitch

Gaines & Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER NEW DAY AT BDC** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) This girl pulled herself together to show well

in winner's class. Classical in type. Pleasing, long head with good profile fill and underjaw. Mouth correct. Eye could be smaller. Good roman finish. Deep, broad chest and correct underline. Round feet. Adequate in bone and overall substance. Topline is acceptable, but would improve with a shorter loin and better tail carriage.

Best of Variety

Ebey & Perrott & Quigg & Berez's **CH. STONEWALL'S HOT ACTION HOLIDAY** (Ch. Lonestar Whole Lota Hoopla ex Ch. Action Quigby Wreaking Havoc) A smart, elegant and feminine bitch with nice fill and dramatic downface. Good eye, expression and tidy ears. Deep underjaw. Mouth correct. Nicely made shoulders. Back firm, but coupling could be shorter. Croup flat. Plenty of bone and power for her moderate size. Adequate angulation fore and aft. Covered ground nicely both ways.
