COLORED BULL TERRIERS: 6-7-(3-4)

WINNERS DOG: Smith's **Magor Man In A Tux** (CH Dajan Top Act With Action & Magor Macy Gray). A really nice black-brindle and white. Head has very good fill, good length and a sweeping profile. Mouth slightly under, with correct canines. Heavy bone, nice shoulder and topline. Movement is good coming and going.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Weiss & Gray's **Zirocon Thunderally Bold Baxter** (CH Mighty Bulls Chap Chester & Ultimate Joy's Special Zircon) Brindle and white. Strong head with good depth of muzzle. A substantial dog with nice bone. Decent mover. Good mouth. Not as shapely as the winners.

WINNERS BITCH & BEST OF WINNERS Smith's **Magor Million Dollar Baby** (CH Dajan Top Act With Action & CH Magor Matchless Matrix) A heavy, but shapely brindle and white. Classic profile with excellent depth and fill, and a good bite. Plenty of bone and substance, true front, with a nice underline and tight feet. Correct mover down and back. Ideally could be a tad shorter in back.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Meyers & Parker's **Nuance Night Moves** (CH Old Forge Tug McGraw At Chevalier & CH Nuance Night And Day) Brindle and white. Pleasing head with fill and profile. Correct mouth. Doesn't have quite the overall power of winners.

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: McGrath's **CH Magor Matinee Special** (CH Acie's Empire Maker & CH Magor Steel Magnolia Of Misk) Brindle and white. A shapely, well made dog with smooth profile, good fill, and depth of muzzle. Scissors bite. Strong topline, and good movement. Decided to quit showing in the end.

BEST OF VARIETY: Lim & Berez **CH Action Head Over Heels II** (CH Action Headed For Fame & CH Dajan Classy Action) Strong head, filled, and turned with good length. Scissors bite. Nice long neck and deep chest. Good bone and substance. Accurate movement both ways.

WHITE BULL TERRIERS: 5-6-(0-2)

WINNERS DOG, BEST OF WINNERS, & BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: Graulau & Wright's **Glentom Conquistador Seeking Silver** (CH Cool Conquistador At

Crossgarley & CH Glentom Silver Lining) Well balanced white dog with good bone. His head is filled and gently turned. Correct mouth. Nice eye, ear placement, and expression. Moved well both coming and going.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Frascone & LaForce's **Sinabar Crime Of Passion** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic & Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) White dog with nice round bone. His head is filled and nicely turned. Great expression. Still a young dog and has time to mature. Movement difficult to assess, as he made things a bit difficult for his handler.

WINNERS BITCH: Jones's **Imperials Truth Hurts** (CH Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley & CH Flashbak's Amazing Grace) A medium sized bitch, with short back and strong quarters. Her head is nicely filled nicely turned. A tiny, dark eye and correct ear placement.. Correct bite. Moved well both coming and going.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Wright's **Glentom LeBeouf's Queen Dancing Creek** (CH Dazlin Defiance & CH Glentom Pearljam De Mint). Nice profile and fill. Mouth correct. Moved well. Still a bit immature. Not as short as winners.

BEST OF VARIETY: Robards & Frascone's **CH Sinabar Exotic At Valentino** (CH Bestuvall Razor Redi Cut & CH Sinabar Aphrodisiac) Compact bitch with a terrific profile, and a well-filled head. Strong underjaw. Nice bone. She has a wicked expression with dark, tiny eye. Wonderful body lines and movement complete the picture. Mouth just off level.
