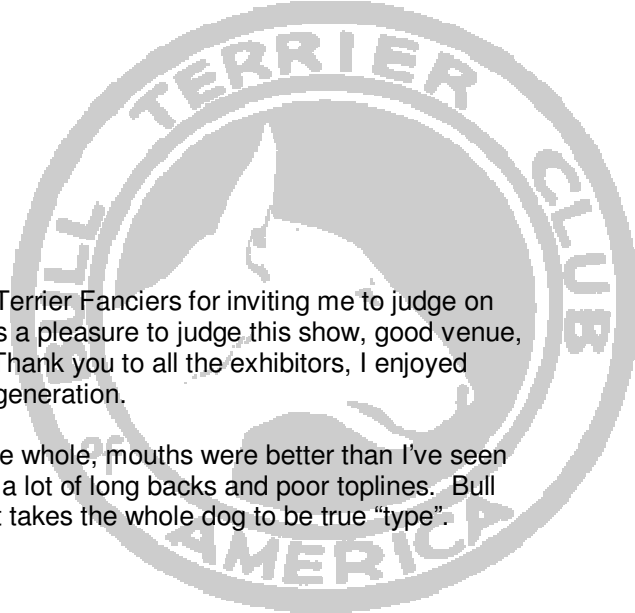


**Illiana Bull Terrier Fanciers

COLORED BULL TERRIERS: 7-9 (5-3)


WINNERS DOG: Matton's **Puzzled's Nocturnal Repo Man** (Teiwgwyn Welsh Dragon-Antler River's Jigsaw Puzzle) Medium size brindle and white. Lovely bone for size, with tight cat feet. A tad long in back. Good bend of stifle. Powerful head piece with good turn and strength of muzzle.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Jones' **Yoeckydoo's Ironman** (Yoeckydoo's Headbanger x Yoeckydoo's Feurouge) Promising youngster. Head is packed with lovely length and turn. Mouth off. Good bone for size. Moved well both coming and going.

WINNERS BITCH & BEST OF WINNERS: Hatten & Frascione's **Sinabar Lyrical Passion** (Sinabar Valenti No Chaotic x Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) Lovely brindle and white. Balanced with good bone for her size. Nice length of neck onto a well laid shoulder, good bend of stifle. Good topline. Head powerful, and of good length. Strong muzzle. Presented in excellent condition.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Woods & Frascione's **Sinabar Lady Labella At Bulloved** (Ch. Bestuwall Razor Redi Cut x Starstruck Peekaboo) Very similar to my winner's bitch. Lovely filled and turned head. Short back with good bend of stifle. Not as much bone as the winner, but overall a very nice bitch.

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: McGrath's **CH Magor Matinee Special** (CH Acie's Empire Maker & CH Magor Steel Magnolia Of Misk) Upstanding brindle and white. His head is well filled with good expression, long sweeping profile with good depth and strength. Sissors bite. Good topline and overall balance. Moved well.



BEST OF VARIETY: Hopkins's **Ch. Terjo's Broken Arrow** (Megavilles Sardonicus x Javarke Calico of Terjo's) Flashy solid brindle Her head is strong, of good length and beautifully turned. Her eyes are well placed with tiny ears carried right on top, good expression. Sissors bite. Well balanced with good bone for size. Moved well coming and going. Shown in beautiful condition.

WHITE BULL TERRIERS: 4-10 (3-1)

WINNERS DOG: Graulau & Wright's **Glentom Conquistador Seeking Silver** (CH Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley & CH Glentom Silver Lining) Powerful youngster, good bone and substance. Head is filled with good length, turn and finish. Mouth correct. On the critical side, I'd like to see more bend of stifle. Movement a little close in the rear. Shown well.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Frascone & LaForce's **Sinabar Crime Of Passion** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic & Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) Nicely balanced white dog. Good shoulder lay back onto a short back, good bend of stifle. Adequate bone for size right down to tight cat feet. Head is of good length, nicely turned with lovely expression. Needs time to mature.

WINNERS BITCH & BEST OF WINNERS: Snider's **Bulliards Good Hearted Woman.** (Ch. Dajan Top Act With Action x Ch. Shadowood Simply Beewitching) Lovely young bitch, short back with good shoulder lay back, well turned stifle. Head is filled and turned with a tiny well placed eye. Nice expression. Mouth correct. Ears carried right on top. Moved well.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Patterson & Wright's **Glentom Rising Star** (Ch. Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley x Ch. Glentom Silver Lining) Another lovely young bitch, it was a hard decision between my winner and reserve, as I felt they were both quality bitches. Substantial young bitch, good bone for size. A tad soft in topline. Head long, and strong, with tiny well placed eye. Moved well.

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: Robards & Frascone's **CH Sinabar Exotic At Valentino** (CH Bestuvall Razor Redi Cut & CH Sinabar Aphrodisiac) Classy medium sized white bitch. Lovely long strong head with good turn, eyes tiny and well placed and tidy ears carried right on top. Mouth slightly off. Nice bone for size, well balanced. Moved well both coming and going.

BEST OF VARIETY: Altmann's **CH Action Dream Come True** (CH Old Forge Tug Mcgraw at Chevalier x CH Action Moonbeam Dream) Clean flowing body

lines, balanced with a good topline, and plenty of bone for size. Moves true. Head is well filled and nicely turned. Lovely expression, with tiny well placed eye and tidy ears carried right on top. A real showman.
