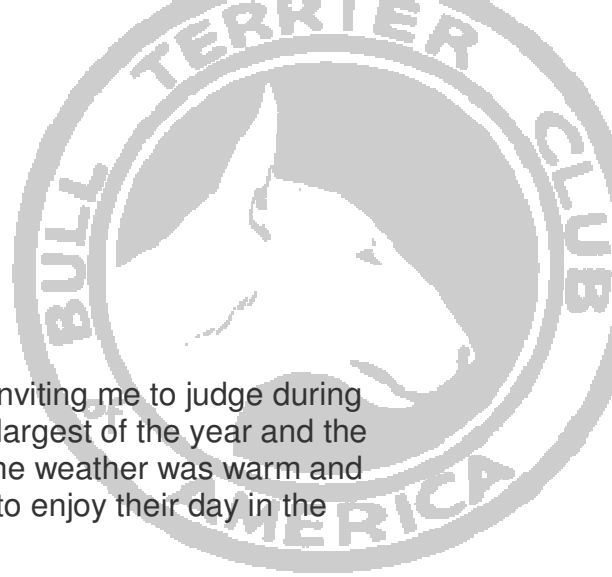


Bull Terrier Club of New England

Reserve Winners Dog

Drechsler & Nadeau's **MAINELY TOUCH OF CHROME** (Ch. Skylines Back in Black ex Ch Corsaire Sparkling Chrome) A nicely constructed brindle and white. He has a long, filled head with good depth. Correct mouth. Nice eye placement. Good bone. Movement is good coming and going and moves out with drive.

Winners Dog, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy

Ibbitson & Bozian's **BULLAYR MAN IN THE MOON AT BAKER ST** (Ch. Gwynsel Its Not Unusual ex Scarlet Moon The Joker) A heavyweight red and white with a sweeping profile. Ears, eyes and bite correct, good reach of neck, shoulders and top line, tail well set, good front and depth of chest, good angulation, moved well in front and with drive from behind.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Hennessy's **WENDIGO BUOY NORTHERN EXPOSURE** (Kiladagh Northern Cross At Dazzlin ex Buoy's Wendigo Sarah In Sable) A well-made black brindle and white with a good head, profile and fill with roman finish. A very slight mouth fault. She has good reach of neck, good forechest, nice spring of rib, straight front. Nice rear angulation. Her movement is good in front, little close behind.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best of Variety

Brodeur's **PHILGIN FINE LINE** (Ch. Sarajeni Rockn At Philgin ex Philgin Dreamcatcher) A balanced black brindle and white with a lovely, sweeping profile. Nice fill under the eyes, bite correct, long reach of neck, good shoulders and topline, nice spring of rib, straight front, good rear angulation. Movement is good coming and going.

Reserve Winners Dog

McGee & Lecki's **BEDLAM'S CHANGING TIMES** (Bedlam's Dashing Dude ex Ch. Bedlam's Sweet November) A medium sized white with an outstanding

expression. Strong filled head although could use more length. Correct mouth. Good forechest, straight front, nice round bone. Rear angulation is good. Movement is good in both directions

Stanton & Chess' **BULZDEN HOBGOBLIN** (Badnuff Royalbard Headliner ex Ch. Bulzden Limited Edition) A large upstanding white dog with lots of bone and substance, powerful head, nice eye, good depth of muzzle, long reach of neck, well laid shoulders, level topline, straight front, good forechest and spring of rib, strong rear angulation, moves well both ways.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Killion & Krukenkamp's **MADCAP WHEN IN ROME** (Ch. Madcap Veni Vidi Vici ex Ch TNG N Buoy's Concrete Blonde NAJ) A lovely feminine bitch with a very nice expression. Head is turned with good fill but could use more length of foreface. Correct bite. Lovely, round bone, well developed ribcage. Nicely developed rear. Movement is a little close going away.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Harris, Deever's & Perrott's **APPRENTICE'S HOLDIN COURT AT ACTION** (Ch. Action King Pin ex Ch. Apprentice's Sittin Pretty) A lovely bitch with a feminine head and excellent expression. A gently sweeping profile, ears well set, nice fill under the eye, bite correct, good reach of neck and shoulders, level topline, straight front, nice spring of rib, strong rear quarters. Movement good coming and going.

Best of Opposite Sex

Killion & Krukenkamp's **CH. TNG N BUOY'S CONCRETE BLONDE NAJ** (Ch. Javarke Mr Jingles ex Ch. Buoy's TNT at TNG) A lovely, feminine white bitch with good expression, sweeping profile and roman finish. Bite correct, good length of neck and top line, straight front, Nice rear angulation. Movement good coming and a little close going away.

Best of Variety

Brodeur's **CH. SARAJENI ROCKN AT PHILGIN** (Sarajeni Bronson ex Sarajeni Village Girl) A power house of a dog, strong, sweeping profile, roman finish, lots of fill under the eyes, ears correct, well laid shoulders, level topline, good front, outstanding rib spring, strong rear quarters, beautiful angulation, very slight mouth fault, nevertheless his virtues out weigh his slight fault, moved well in front and back with drive.
