Winners Dog, Best of Winners

Woodman's Skylines The Aftermath of Dazzlin

(Kiladagh Northern Cross at Dazzlin ex Skyline Black Magic). Stylish very shapely black brindle dog with a dramatic profile, good expression, wide well filled up foreface and deep muzzle, unfortunate faulty bite, adequate substance for his size, very well made behind the collar and moves accordingly.

Reserve Winners Dog

Bavol's **Old England's Falcon** (Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke ex Ch. Old England's Lady Elizabeth). Young red smut, another dramatic profile with very good fill and depth, correct bite, front tucked up under the ribs, nice short body proportions, moved and showed well.

Winners Bitch

Myers and Parker's **Nuance Night Moves** (Ch. Old Forge Tug McGraw at Chevalier ex Ch. Nuance Night Moves). Feminine brindle and white with a very good profile with good roman finish, well filled with very good depth at the muzzle, good expression, her outline has very good proportions in body length and depth and a correct topline, moved very well, and never let down in the heat.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Hains and Berez' **Action Broadway Queen** (Action One in a Million ex Action Voodoo Princess). Black brindle and white bitch, very good profile, fill, and strength to her head, correct bite, gave way a bit in proportions to the winner, maintained her good topline in spite of the hot conditions and moved well around the ring.

Best of Opposite Sex, Select

Weiss and Gray's **Ch. Zircon Thunderally Bold Baxter** (Ch. Mighty Bulls Chap Chester ex Ultimate Joy's Special Zircon). Strapping solid brindle dog with a wide powerful head, very good profile, very good substance, good front and rear angles, correct topline, moved freely with his longer body length.

Best of Variety, Select

Cash, Schneider, and Wright's **Ch. Glentom LeBouf's Countess Singing Cloud** (Ch. Dazzlin Defiance ex Ch. Glentom Pearljam DeMint RN). Red smut bitch who in silhouette is the picture of square proportions, she has excellent length to her head with a very good smooth profile, completely filled foreface, well made front assembly, adequate rear angles, fully developed since I judged her last, she now has spring of rib and a shapely underline, moves well when she settles.

Winners Dog

Korczyk and Hutter's **Epiphany St. Augustine of Hippo** (Apprentice Man-in-Action ex Blueprint Glass Onion). Dark brindle marked dog with an adequate profile, good fill, good depth at the muzzle, very good bone and substance, short coupled body with a good topline, moved well when settled a bit.

Reserve Winners Dog

Patton's **Gigantic-Giant Ivan** (Moonflower Chasper ex Koros Mennti Magic Greta). Well made dog with smooth body lines and good movement, incisors correct, adequately filled head, shown well.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners

Uplinger and Radford's **Mayhem Hot to Trot** (Ch. Kilacabar Cuchulainn ex Ch. Mayhem Popen' Hot). Striking all white bitch, smooth dramatic profile, well filled up foreface, strong muzzle, lovely body proportions and angles with a correct topline, moved well.

Best of Opposite Sex, Select

Schneider and Wright's **Ch. LeBeouf Beaucoup Blanc of Glentom** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance ex Ch. Glenton Pearljam DeMint). Powerful dog with a wide strong head, good profile, excellent expression, well made at both ends, good topline, very deep chest with good ribspring, moved well as expected.

Best of Breed, Select

Stafford and Poole's **Ch. Rocky Top's Simply Irresistible** (Alecto Kool Barracuda of Kilacabar ex Ch. Rocky Top's Honey 'N Rainbows). Substantail tri-color eyepatched bitch with a long strong filled head, smooth well turned profile, correct scissors bite, adequate expression, good length of neck to tightly constructed front assembly, correct topline, moved well in front, good tail set.

Berez' **Ch. Dajan Top Act with Action**, Snider and Long's **Ch. Bullard's Good Hearted Woman**.
