There were two or three comments that continually crept into the thought process as I watched the dogs go around the ring. "Hey, Bob most of the dog has pretty nice side gait. Wish they didn't carry their tail so high." The one I found most recurring and the easiest to rectify was "Why don't these folks cut their dog toe nails." I saw time and time again, feet that were starting to splay, pasterns that were beginning to look weak and dogs that walked like their feet hurt. There were only a few dogs that were undershot. I was pleased to see that the majority of the dogs had level or scissor bites. I found ears seemed a bit large and at times carried wide and angled away from the skull. "When alert the small, thin ears placed close together pointing upwards."

COLORED Winners Dog

Anita and Walter Bavol's **OLD ENGLAND'S MONTGOMERY**

(Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke x Ch Old England's Lady Elizabeth)BBE dog. A young dog with a square profile and a good topline. He is well ribbed up and has a lot of bone. The dog had a nice, well balanced head. Small ears. A triangular eye shape. Slight rise over the loin. Feet are fairly tight. In viewing the side gait the forelegs reached out well and the hind legs moved smoothly.

Reserve Winners Dog

J &D Scheibly, Anita and Walter Bavol's **OLD ENGLAND'S FALCON**

(Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke x Ch Old England's Lady Elizabeth) 12 to 18 months

A litter mate of the Winners Dog. He is greater in length from muzzle to eye than from eye to occiput. He has a proper scissor bite. Length of body is good with a slight rise over the loin. His underline show a slight tuck up. Good coming and going.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners

Anita and Walter Bavol's **OLD ENGLAND'S COCO CHANEL**

(Tulsadom Abi Albon x Ch. Old England's Milady in Red) 9 to 12 months. A litter mate to the Winner's Dog. A good oval head that could have a bit more fill below the eyes. Ears were small. Strong under jaw. Good blend of the neck into the shoulders. There was a slight rise over the loin and a very good underline. The tail was a little long and was carried high when moving. She moved with her legs parallel coming and going. She has a jaunty gait flexing well at both the stifle and the hock joints.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Schneider and Bradbury's **LEBEOUF DUCHESS SOARING OF GLENTOM**

(Ch Dazlin Defiance x Ch Glentom's Pearl Jam Demint RN) American Bred.

A full bodied dog, solidly built with a slight rise over the loin. Nice length of body with a slight tuck up. The tail was thick were it joined the body. Good head shape with the length of muzzle from eye to nose greater the eye to occiput. She has a triangular eye. The dog moved well coming and going.

Best of Variety

Terry & Mike Courmoyer and Glenna Wright's **CH. GLENTOM'S YOU WERE MEANT FOR ME**
(Ch Cool Conquistador at Crossgarley x Glentom's Mint Julep)

The bitch has a very nice head with a good eye shape. The ears are set close together and carried high. The mouth is correct and she has a good under jaw. Her neck blends nicely into the shoulders. She is square. There is a slight rise over the loin. The underline has a graceful

curve upward. She has tight feet. Dog moves with hocks parallel both coming and going. Side movement showed agility and power. A dog with a very pleasing look about her.

Best of Opposite Sex

Salazar and Salas's CH AM. AND MEX. NOCTURNAL KNIGHT AT ARNOLDS

(Tierwgywn Welsh Dragon x Nosey Parker The Imperial Wizard) A red and white dog. The dog has a long head piece well fill to the nose. The bite is good. He has a well defined under jaw. Long neck, firm topline, good depth of chest and plenty of bone. He has a nice underline with a good tuck up. Nice dog coming and going.

Winners Dog,

Rafael Fernandez's **ARES THE UNIQUE** (CH Nocturnal Knight at Arnolds x Alfa) Open Dog. The dog has a nice clean oval head shape. Nice triangular eye shape. Ear are nicely set on. The dog has a good topline with a good tuck up. Moved with a jaunty gait.

Reserve Winners Dog

Annalee Cox's **SOME OKIES KNIGHT OF D'BULL** (CH Nocturnal Knight at Arnolds x Biondi D'Rock and Bull). 6 to 9months. A good shaped head, a nice ear set and a good blend of the neck into the shoulders. Shoulders were well laid back and good spring of rib. A good topline with a slight rise over the loin and a slight drop to the set on of the tail. He moved with his legs parallel viewed from both the front and the rear.

Winners Bitch

Peterson and Wright's **GLENTOM'S RISING STAR** (Ch Cool Conquistador at Crossgarley x Glentom's Silver Lining) BBE. A good shaped head, a nice ear set and a good blend of the neck into the shoulders. Scissors bite. Shoulders were well laid back and good spring of rib. A good topline which had a slight rise over the loin. She moved with her legs parallel viewed from both the front and the back. From the side she flexed well both at the stifle and the hock.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Jake and Heather Jones, **IMPERIAL TRUTH HURTS**, (Ch Cool Conquistador at Crossgarley x Ch Flashback's Amazing Grace) American Bred. Nice head piece, ears well set, the neck blends well into the shoulders. Scissors bite. Well laid back shoulders and a good spring of rib. A good topline with a slight rise over the loin and a slight drop to the set on of the tail. She moved with her legs parallel viewed from both the front and the back. From the side she flexes well both at the stifle and the hock.

Best of Variety

Phyllis Azeur's **CH BULLY MANOR'S PURE PANDEMONIUM** (Ch Miramax Maximillion x Bullovers Baily Cream) the dog has a beautiful head with a nice triangle eye. She has great expression that is enhanced by a strong underjaw. Te bite is slightly off. Neck blends nicely into the shoulders. The fore chest is full but not over exaggerated. The topline is level with a slight rise over the loin. The underline has a graceful curve upward. Tail was carried horizontally. Side movement showed agility and power. Moved parallel both coming and going.

Best of Opposite Sex

Phyllis Azeur's **CH BULLY MANOR'S PURE PANDEMONIUM** (Ch Miramax Maximillion x Bullovers Baily Cream) a litter mate to the Best of Variety. The dog has a good head piece with fill under the eye and small ears carried well. The ears are placed on top of the head which contributes to the desired keen expression. He has a well defined under jaw. He has a large fore chest coupled with a good placement of the shoulder. There is plenty of bone. The set on of the tail is correct. The problem I had in placing him over the bitch was the overall proportions. He seemed a bit longer and she appeared more compact.
