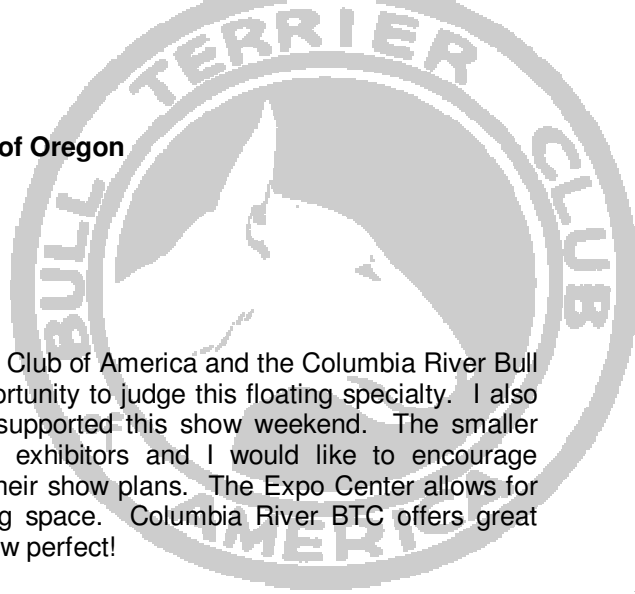


**Columbia River Bull Terrier Club of Oregon

Winners Dog

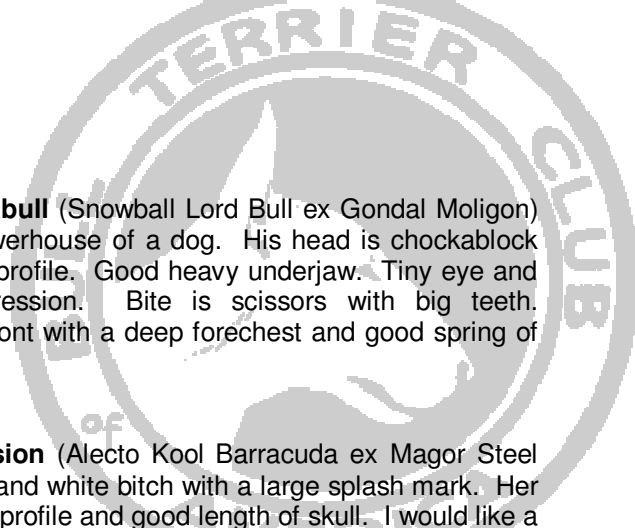
Ryan & Watson's **CSF-Remy** (Thunderforce Masked Firestorm ex Darkstarts Classis Rosewood) Young, upstanding solid black brindle that is fairly square. He has good length of foreface, but lacks profile and fill. Bite is scissors. His tiny eye and small ears right on top of his head give him good expression. He has a straight front with good bone. He has a short upper arm and lacks angulation and muscle development in the rear and it is revealed in his movement. He needs to body up and roadwork would help develop his rear assembly.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Cooper's **Cooper's Grace** (MI 1 Ton's Like Father Like Son ex Miss Rufi Hotshot) A tri-color puppy that needs time to mature. She has a gentle profile with good length of foreface and underjaw. Bite is undershot. Good expression and ear set. Nice reach of neck. Nice forechest with a straight front, but slightly upright in the shoulder. Body is just off-square. Good rear angulation. Good tail set.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Alexander's **Brigadoon Tinker Bell** (Ch. Desert Kahu Ko Vom Jubel ex Ch. Brigadoon's Baroness Essex) Brindle and white bitch with a good profile with roman finish. She has good length of skull and a good underjaw. Scissors bite. Ear set could be a bit tidier. Good reach of neck. She has a straight front and good bone. She is slightly longer cast. She has good rear angulation. On the move, she is better coming than going.



Best of Opposite Sex

Smith's **Ch. Black Shark De Rocabull** (Snowball Lord Bull ex Gondal Moligon) A well-known tri-color that is a powerhouse of a dog. His head is chockablock full of fill, but could use a stronger profile. Good heavy underjaw. Tiny eye and good ear set enhance his expression. Bite is scissors with big teeth. Tremendous bone and a straight front with a deep forechest and good spring of rib.

Best of Variety

Myall & Smith's **Magor Islay Passion** (Alecto Kool Barracuda ex Magor Steel Magnolia of Misk) Upstanding red and white bitch with a large splash mark. Her head has a beautiful, gently curved profile and good length of skull. I would like a bit more fill under the eyes. Nice varminty expression. Ears are set right up on top of her head. Scissors bite. Lovely reach of neck and one of the better shoulder assemblies on the day. Straight front with good forechest, good bone and nice cat feet. Squarely made with good rear angulation and well-let-down hocks. Rear is well-muscled. Moved better coming than going.

Select Bitch

Vincent & Ruppel's **Ch. Quicksilver Lickity Split** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) A quality brindle and white bitch that was unfortunate to meet up with the BOV today. Her profile is gently curved with good roman finish. She has good fill. Scissors bite. Good reach of neck. Her front is straight with a good forechest and she has adequate bone for her size. Slightly longer cast than the BOV winner. She has good rear angulation.

WHITE 1-2-(0-2) 2 absentees

Winners Dog, Best of Winners and Best of Variety

Martin & Morden's **Rhydaman Frosty** (Emred Huntsman ex Rhydaman Dream Catcher) A medium-sized white dog that is a big package for his size. He has a lot of virtues. Although he is shorter faced, he has good fill and a gently curved profile with good roman finish. He has a scissors bite with large teeth. Varminty expression. He has beautiful round bone and a straight front with a good forechest. His body is just off-square. Good rear angulation. Clean movement coming and going.

Winners Bitch and Best of Opposite Sex

Alexander & Bailey's **Brigadoon Miss Buxley** (Brigadoon The Butler Did It ex Ch. Brigadoon Baronesse Essex) A smaller white puppy with a brindle eye mark on the off side. Her head has a gently curved profile with good roman finish. Scissors bite. Varminty expression. Ear set could be a bit tidier. Mouth is correct. Nice straight front. Her body is just off-square. She has a clean undercarriage with good tuck up. Good rear angulation. On the move she is a bit high in the rear with a tail set that could be a bit lower. Beautiful cat feet. Fluid on the move.

Select Bitch

Clasen & Ruppel's **Ch. Quicksilver San Juan Girl** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) This heavyweight girl was unfortunate to run up against the younger bitch. Her head has a gently curved profile with good roman finish. Nice varminty expression. Good depth of underjaw. Mouth is scissors. Her ear set could be a bit tidier. Straight front with a good forechest and bone. She is a bit shorter in back than the class bitch but her rear is over angulated and it shows on the move as she moved closer in the rear.
