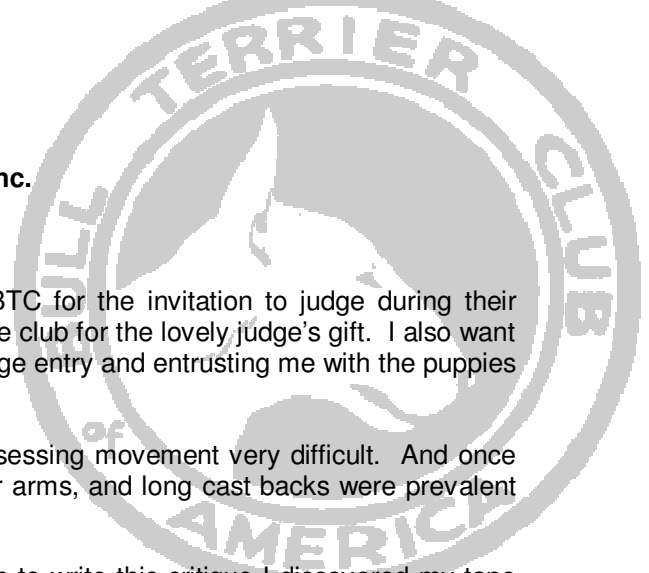


Buckeye Bull Terrier Club

Much to my dismay, when I sat down to write this critique I discovered my tape was blank for white class placements. Thankfully I had my photographs for reference.

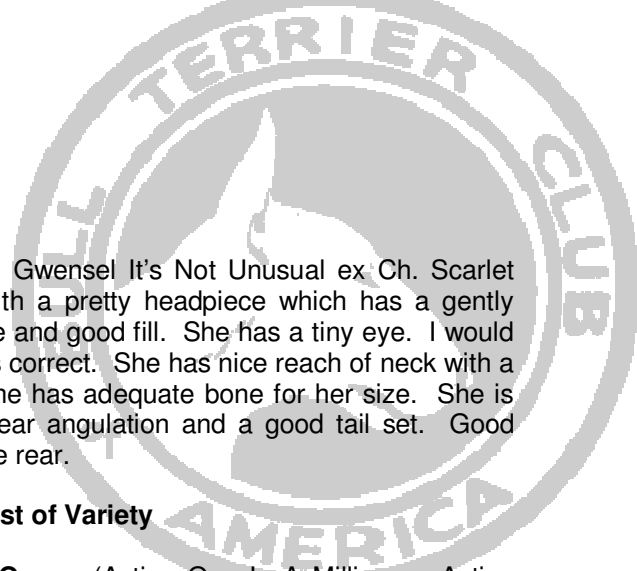
COLORED

Reserve Winners Dog

Bavol's **Old England's Montgomery** (Silver Bullet The Joker ex Ch. Old England's Lady Elizabeth) Medium-sized red and white dog who was pushed by his littermate for this placement but won on better rear movement. His head has a shorter foreface. He has a small eye that gives him good expression. Reach of neck is good. He has a nice forechest and straight front with adequate bone for his size. He has a level topline and an good tuck up. His rear angulation is good and his hocks are well-let-down. The tail set could be better and he carries it high on the move.

Winners Dog, Best of Opposite Sex

Lamnek, Evans & Berez's **Glactic Action Packed** (Super Bowl's Foreigner ex Actions Queen Andromeda) Medium-sized black brindle that is a lot of dog for the package. He has a good strong dog head with gentle curve to the profile and very good fill. His mouth is off. He has a strong underjaw. His tiny eye and good ear placement enhance his expression. He has nice reach of neck. The front assembly is straight with good strong bone and a good forechest. I would prefer just a bit more length of upper arm. His body is just off square. He has a smooth topline with a good tail set and clean undercarriage. He has moderate rear angulation and well-let-down hocks. He moved right out. Shown in good condition.



Reserve Winners Bitch

Bozian's **Bullayr Moonshadow** (Ch. Gwensel It's Not Unusual ex Ch. Scarlet Moon The Joker) A black brindle with a pretty headpiece which has a gently curved profile, good length of foreface and good fill. She has a tiny eye. I would prefer a bit smaller ear size. Mouth is correct. She has nice reach of neck with a good forechest and straight front. She has adequate bone for her size. She is slightly longcast but has moderate rear angulation and a good tail set. Good tuckup. She moves slightly high in the rear.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best of Variety

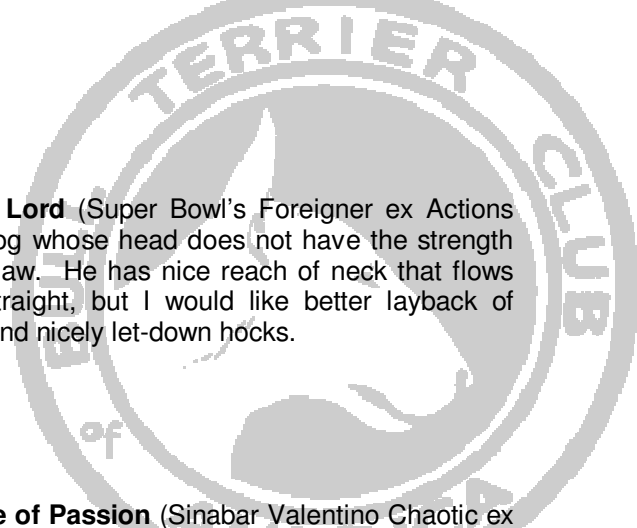
Hains & Berez's **Action Broadway Queen** (Action One In A Million ex Action Voodoo Princess) A lovely black brindle with a lot of virtues and smooth lines that flow from front to rear. She is compact and cobby. Her head has a beautiful, gently curved profile with good fill. A tiny eye and good ear set give her good varminty expression. Her bite is reverse scissors. She has good reach of neck that flows into a good topline and tail set. She is just off square in make. Her front is straight with good bone for her size. She has good rear angulation and well-let-down hocks. She has good tuck up. It was an easy decision to place her Best of Variety.

Select Dog

Weiss & Gray's **Ch. Zircxon Thunderally Bold Baxter** (Ch. Mighty Bull's Chap Chester ex Ultimate Joy's Special Zircon) Almost solid brindle with a packed up head. Good gently curved profile. He has tiny eyes. His mouth is just off. He has good depth of underjaw. He has a good forechest with a straight front and very good bone. His undercarriage has good tuck up. Good rear angulation and well-let-down hocks. He is slightly longer cast than the opposite sex winner.

Select Bitch

Jones' **Ch. Imperials Undisputed Attitude** (Ch. Cool Conquistator At Crossgarley ex Ch. Flashback's Amazing Grace) Red and white bitch whose head has a good profile and good fill. She has a good eye and a good ear set. She has depth to her underjaw. Her front is straight with good bone for her size. She has nice reach of neck that flows into her topline which is level. She is slightly long cast. The tail set is good. Her undercarriage is clean. Good rear angulation.



WHITE

Reserve Winners Dog

Guzzo and Evans **Galactic Inferno Lord** (Super Bowl's Foreigner ex Actions Queen Andromeda) A larger white dog whose head does not have the strength of the winner. Good depth of underjaw. He has nice reach of neck that flows into a level topline. His front is straight, but I would like better layback of shoulder. Moderate rear angulation and nicely let-down hocks.

Winners Dog

Frascone & LaForce's **Sinabar Crime of Passion** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic ex Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) A large young dog that has a nicely filled head with a gently curved profile. Nice tiny eye. Good reach of neck. He has a good forechest and straight front. Good spring of rib for his age. He is long cast, but still a powerful package.

Reserve Winners Bitch

McConnell & Baval's **Old England's White Imperial Empress** (Tulsadom Abi Albon ex Ch. Old England's Lady in Red) A large white bitch carrying red markings. She has a lovely head with a beautiful gently curved profile. She has good reach of neck and a good forechest. A straight front and good bone. Her body lines flow smoothly from front to back although she is fairly long cast. She has a level topline with a good tail set. She has well-let-down hocks.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners

Ibbitson's **Baker St Brass Bonanza of Aragon-Ruffin** (Ch. Baker St Back To Bonanza ex Ch. Horizon's Harmony of Aragon) A typey, cobby, small bitch with red ear markings. She has a gently curved profile with good fill. I would like a bit more length of skull. She has a correct bite. A varminty expression with small well-placed ears. She has a reachy neck that flows into a good topline and tail set. Her front is straight with good bone. Squarely made. Hocks are well-let-down. I would like to see a better laid shoulder and just a bit more rear angulation.

Best of Opposite Sex

Schneider & Wright's **Ch. LeBeouf Beaucoup Blanc of Glentom** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance ex Ch Glentom Pearljam De Mint RN) A large white dog whose head has a gently curved profile and good fill. Small eye and good ear set. He has good reach of neck. A straight front with a good forechest and good bone. Slightly long cast. He has a level topline and a good tail set. Moderate rear angulation. He moved the best of the males in competition.

Best of Variety

Idone & Berez's **Ch. Action Chaos I'm So Delicious** (Ch. Brummagem Chips Ahoy ex Ch. Action Chaos And Charisma) A lovely white bitch with brindle ear marking. She has good length of skull with a gently curved profile. She has very good fill. Mouth is correct. Her tiny eyes and good ear set give her good varminty expression. She has a straight front with good forechest, a gun-barrel front and good bone. She has lovely reach of neck and a smooth topline. Clean undercarriage. Good rear angulation. Well-let-down hocks. I would prefer a shorter back. She moved right out and moved the best in the specials class. She was pushed hard by the Winners Bitch, but won out with her better front construction.
