I would like to thank the Buckeye Bull Terrier Club for inviting me to judge their show and the exhibitors for their entries. I was particularly impressed with the depth of quality in bitches.

COLORED BULL TERRIERS: 3-16-(5-3)

WINNERS DOG, BEST OF WINNERS & BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: Scheibleys and Baval's **Old England's Falcon** (Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke & Ch Old England's Lady Elizabeth) Upstanding red with smooth profile and nice finish. Correct bite. Nice reachy neck. Correct eye placement and expression. Level topline which he holds on the move. A little loose in the front which should tighten as he matures. Still just a year old, so he has time to get even better.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Baval's **Old England's Montgomery** ((Silver Bullet the Joker at Javarke & Ch Old England's Lady Elizabeth) Red and white litter brother to the winners dog. Similar make and shape. Not quite the substance and power of winners.

WINNERS BITCH : Hains and Berez's **Action Broadway Queen** (Action One in a Million & Action Voodoo Princess)) Substantial black brindle and white, shown in excellent condition. Her head is well filled up with good turn and finish. Correct mouth. Nice short back, good shoulder and rear angulation. Moved well both ways.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: Snyder and Fike's **Caben n Paradox Sweet Muse-IC** (Ch Terjos The Vital Spark & Ch Paradox Sweet Muse-Ic to my Ears) Brindle and white with a well filled and turned head. Plenty of bone for her size. Correct canines although slightly undershot. Slightly upright in shoulder.

BEST OF VARIETY: Lim & Berez's **Ch Action Head Over Heels II** (Ch Action Headed For Fame & Ch Dajan Classy Action) Brindle and white with good bone and substance. She has a strong head, filled, and turned with good length. Correct bite. Nice long neck and deep chest. Good movement both coming and going.

WHITE BULL TERRIERS: 3-9-(2-2)

WINNERS DOG: Frascone & LaForce's **Sinabar Crime Of Passion** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic & Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) White dog with really good bone. Nice headpiece with fill and turn. Good eye placement and expression. Movement a little wide coming and good going.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG: Collins's **Real Clowns Tottenham Stryker** (Dutch Dreamer at Skyline Bullpostition & Brigadoon Bright White Hope) A young white dog with nice bone, head and expression. Movement difficult to assess as he made things somewhat difficult for his handler.

WINNERS BITCH & BEST OF WINNERS: Schuur's **Sarajeni Pretty White Satin** (Ch. Pretty Boy Floyd the Joker & Sarajeni Paris) A mature white bitch with a very strong head. She has great depth of muzzle with a long foreface, which is well packed under her eyes. Correct mouth. Excellent bone. Moved well coming and going. To be critical, could be a tad shorter in back.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH: McConnell & Baval's **Old England's White Imperial Princess** (Tulsadom Abi Abion x CH Old England's Lady in Red) An upstanding, well made bitch with a correct shoulder and a well angulated rear. Correct mouth. Moves well both ways. Head just lacks the power of the winners.

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: Idone & Berez's **Action Chaos I'm So Delicious** (Ch. Brummagen Chips Ahoy X Ch. Action Chaos and Charisma) A medium sized bitch which presents a striking silhouette. Lovely packed up head with tiny eye and ears carried right on top. Wonderful expression. Well angulated front and rear. Excellent bone for size.

BEST OF VARIETY: Schneider & Wright's, **Lebeof Beaucoup Blanc of Glentom** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance x Ch. Glentom Pearljam De Mint) A typy young dog that I really like. He has good head with length, fill, and turn. Well balanced with really good bone. Good front and shoulder with a short back. Nice eye and ear placement makes for great expression. Moved well both coming and going. Mouth just off.
