## **COLORED**

### **Reserve Winners Dog**

Dykema & Coy's **BESTUVALL SHO' IS HOT** (Quicksilver Showstopper ex Ch. Bestuvall Believes She's Hot) A black brindle and white of good size. Super profile and Roman finish. Wonderful eye and fill. A bit iffy on the canines. Splendid neck. Good balance and shape. Very typey. Moved close behind.

### **Winners Dog**

Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER MONSTER TRUCK** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) A brindle and white heavy-weight. Massive, fully filled head with super profile and Roman finish. Correct bite. Bit lazy with ears. Tremendous bone and substance and thus not too shapely. Moved well to and fro.

### **Reserve Winners Bitch**

Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER GOING TO GRACELAND** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) Brindle and white of mid size. A very shapely, short-backed bitch with great charm. A quality head with very good profile and fill, correct bite. Adequate bone and substance for size. Good proportions and shape. Moved well front and rear.

### **Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex**

Dykema's **BESTUVALL TOO HOT TO STOP** (Quicksilver Showstopper ex Ch. Bestuvall Believes She's Hot) A big impressive brindle and white, just shy of heavyweight status. A super, fully filled head, with wonderful profile. Great foreface and depth of muzzle. Correct bite. Wonderful bone and substance. Notable for her shapeliness. Strong short back. Moved better in front than behind. A quality bitch.

### **Best of Variety**

Smiths' **CH. BLACK SHARK DE ROCABULL** (Snowball Lord Bull ex Gondola Moligon) A massive heavyweight tri-color. Is as sound as a dollar when the dollar was sound. Has a massive head which could be improved with more fill and profile, still it exudes power. Wonderful neck. Bone and substance are eye-boggling, thus not too shapely. Great mover, front and rear. Shows like a bomb. Sure he has some defects, but his virtues carry him a long way. Was please to place him Fourth in the Group.

## **WHITE**

### **Reserve Winners Dog**

Vail & Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER SAILOR MAN** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) A heavyweight with massive bone and substance. A very good heavyweight, tad flat mid profile. Good Roman finish. Canines correct. Incisors just off. Super eye. Great volume in body. Good rear angulation. Moved well.

### **Winners Dog and Best of Winners**

West & Myall's **ICENI WESTPOINT** (Ch. Bullenium Big Bazooka ex Ch. Icen Point Taken) A mid size dog showing with great enthusiasm. He didn't miss a thing – including the border collies in the next ring. A super head with great fill and profile. Wonderful eyes. Canines OK. Incisors just

off. Very good bone and substance for size. Good forechest and shoulder. Wonderful sweeps and curves. Very good rear angulation. A handful at this stage.

**Reserve Winners Bitch**

Utt & Gothan's **BULLARDS N ARDRYS HOT ICE** (Ch. Andry Desert Heat ex Ch. Jael's Hammer of Bullards) Brindle head mark. A very good headed youngster that seemed to improve the more you looked at her. Medium size with good bone and substance. Very well balanced with a short back. Head has most of what you want: Profile, fill, bite and eye – all correct. Moved very well, especially behind.

**Winners Bitch and Best of Opposite Sex**

Clasen & Ruppel's **QUICKSILVER SAN JUAN GIRL** (Ch. Moxie's Rockabilly Quicksilver ex Quicksilver Just Whistle) On the small size but with all the requisite breed virtues. Extremely shapely and accented with charm. Head is balanced with very good profile and fill. Correct bite. Wonderful eye. Moderate in bone and substance in keeping with her size. Well angulated rear. Back could be shorter. Moved well around as well as up and down.

**Best of Variety**

Ruppel's **CH. STELLAR QUICKSILVER SHOWSHOCKER** (Quicksilver Showstopper ex Ch. Stellar's Pictures of You) A heavyweight dog that completely fills your eye. A super head, long balanced and strong. Excellent piercing eyes. Profile and fill all there. Abundant bone and substance. Strong correct topline. Very good rear angulation. Surprising good shape for size. Coat a bit off on the day. A top quality dog. Was pleased to place him Second in the Terrier Group.
