## **COLOURED**

### **Reserve Winners Dog**

Thompson's **SKYLINE'S IN HOT PURSUIT** (Marshelsea How's About Harry ex CH Skyline's Sticks'N'Stones) Confident puppy, red & white, with a half white face of extreme "fatness". He's an absolute delight to see head-on, with appropriate round bone and a ram-rod straight front. His bite was correct, although his canines weren't all the way up due to his extreme youth. He's lovely and square, with a well bent rear and I'll be very interested to see all that potential come to maturity. Movement was still puppy-erratic.

### **Winners Dog**

Hueys' **CRESTMONT'S SAVOIR FAIRE** (Ch Cool Conquistador At Crossgraley ex Ch Crestmont Chances R Bestuvall) This is a masculine brindle, stronger in the front end than the rear. His powerful head is very impressive, having both profile and width, with dramatic finish and a wicked little eye, ears right on top of his head. His mouth is regrettable. He has big round bone, and a decent shoulder. He carries excessive roach over the croup, stifles are well bent, but his movement was difficult to assess as he was not inclined to settle down.

### **Reserve Winners Bitch**

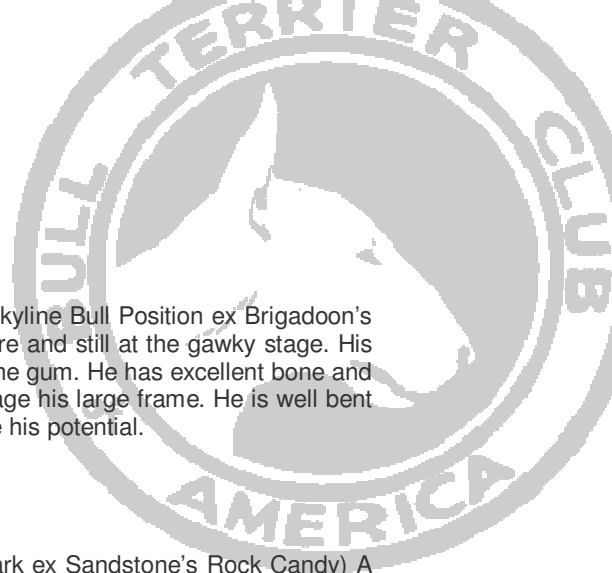
Robichauds' **BULLAYR BARK AT THE MOON** (Ch Gwynsel It's Not Unusual ex Ch Scarlet Moon The Joker) A lovely red & white girl, again with terrific substance and a big, deep body. She is slightly longer in back than the WB and gives way a bit in expression, but a powerful, long head with good ears on top of her head. Her bite is correct incisors with one tight canine. Good shoulders lead to a solid topline and well developed rear. Beautifully presented, she moved cleanly all ways of the ring.

### **Winners Bitch/Best of Winners/Best of Variety**

Hatten & Frascione's **SINABAR LYRICAL PASSION** (Sinabar Valentino Chaotic ex Sinabar Bayhill Passion Potion) This is a powerhouse of a brindle bitch, with a long, strong and gently turned head. Her bite is just off level, with correct canines. She has a long arched neck leading to a beautiful deep body, round bone, and correct tail set. To be critical, I'd like a stronger topline just behind the withers, but she moved well all ways of the ring and was a picture of bull-type virtues without losing her femininity.

### **Best of Opposite Sex**

Bavols & Scheibleys' **CH OLD ENGLAND'S FALCON** (Silver Bullet The Joker at Javarke ex Ch Old England Lady Elizabeth) A moderate red & white boy with good bone for his size, he has a gently turned head with good eyes and well placed ears. His bite is correct with one canine slightly tight at the gumline. He offers good balance through out, strong rear quarters, and a clean front. I'd like to see more width at the muzzle and better Roman finish to complete the picture. Well presented and moved out cleanly all ways of the ring.



## **WHITE**

### **Reserve Winners Dog**

Collin's **REAL CLOWNS TOTTENHAM STRYKER** (Dutch Dreamer at Skyline Bull Position ex Brigadoon's Bright White Hope) This is a big youngster, very pretty and very immature and still at the gawky stage. His head is nicely turned, incisors level but uneven, with one canine tight to the gum. He has excellent bone and would benefit from some conditioning to help him figure out how to manage his large frame. He is well bent in the quarters, clean in front and needs some time and maturity to realize his potential.

### **Winners Dog & Best of Opposite Sex**

Whitehair's **SANDSTONE'S UILLEANN PIPER** (Ch Terjos the Vital Spark ex Sandstone's Rock Candy) A typey, square and moderate boy carrying brindle, this balanced dog has a long, nicely turned head with a tiny, well placed eye. His ears could be a bit tidier and I'd like to see a bit more width carried through the muzzle. His bite is just off. He carries his elbows tucked right into his deep chest, and moves strongly off his well developed rear quarters.

### **Reserve Winners Bitch**

Jabcuga's **SANDSTONE SENECA CORNHUSK DOLL** (Sandstone's Rolling Rock ex Napier Works Like A Charm) Another competitive white bitch, this girl has a lovely headpiece with mouth just off. Good eyes and ears complete her arresting head-on expression. She's square and beautifully balanced, with bone appropriate for her size. Well developed rear quarters would be better balanced with a bit more shoulder layback. She moves cleanly, and is typey and virtuous.

### **Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best of Variety**

Bavols & MsConnells' **OLD ENGLAND'S WHITE IMPERIAL EMPRESS** (Tulsadom Abi Albon ex Ch Old England's Milady In Red ) This bitch caught my eye right away; she a breathtakingly typey creature, square and balanced with a deep body, powerful quarters and lovely, round bone. She moves cleanly and with great presence. To cap it off, she has an absolutely beautiful head; long, strong and beautifully turned, with good finish and width carried all the way to the end of her muzzle. Her bite is correct. Head on, she's as pleasing as she is in profile. Her wicked little eyes are correctly placed, her tiny ears are bang up on top of her head. She has a straight front, elbows well tucked into her broad chest. What a credit to her owners and breeders; her Group Two was well-deserved.
