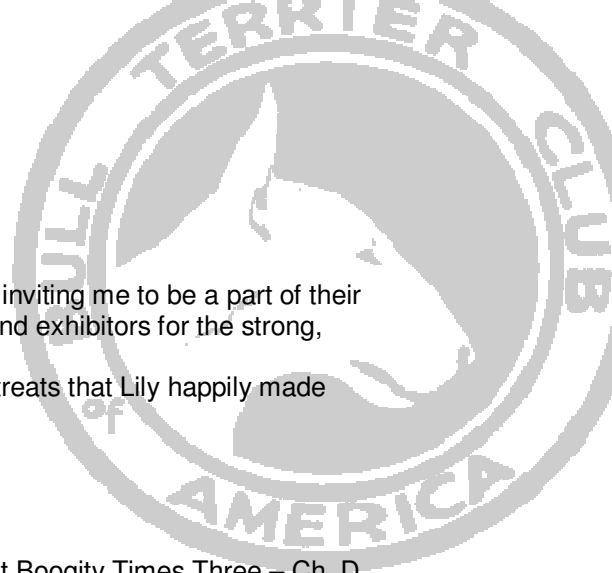


Mile High Bull Terrier Club

Winners Dog

Davis and Holmes' **D BAR IRON MIKE SHERLOCK** (Ch. Beaujest Boogity Times Three – Ch. D Bar Sweet Lou) A brindle and white heavyweight with quite a powerful head with excellent width and finish and a piercing expression. His bite is correct. He has immense bone with loads of substance. Even for such a bully type he's constructed well with a clean shoulder though I would prefer a bit more bend of stifle. Moves well all directions of the ring.

Reserve Winners Dog

Wright's **GLENTOM PLAYING WITH FIRE** (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty – Ch. Glentom's Sneak Preview) A handsome red and white with a very pleasing head with ample turn and width and also a correct bite. Ears, eye and expression are spot on. His body is shapely with ample bone and balanced substance appropriate for his size. His quarters are strong with sufficient angulation. He moves typically with good drive all ways of the ring.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Belstock, Frascone and Niehouse's **BELBAR WILL O' THE WISP** (Ch. Sinabar Bellagio – Ch. Belbar Desert Mahogany) A very pretty brindle and white in a tidy package. Her head is long with a smooth profile, sufficient width and depth and good expression with a small, correctly placed eye and alert ears right on top of her head. Bite is correct. She stands four-square with ample bone and substance for her size and her shoulder and rear are well angulated. She moves very well up, back and in profile.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Larson and Hoare's **NIMROD'S BRONWYN OF BETON** (Ch. Miramax Maxillion – Beton Winsor's Full House) An attractive tri-color with a nice, feminine head with satisfactory fill and width. Her bite is correct. She's made well with enough substance and bone, a clean shoulder with a nicely bent rear though to me doesn't appear quite as balanced as the Winners Bitch. She moves well in profile and coming in, just less so going away.

Best of Variety

Croucher's **CH. ACIE'S JACK SPARROW** (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty – Ch. Acie's One More Look) A handsome brindle and white who I last judged as an 8 month old puppy and has now fully matured. His head is very good with an eye-catching profile, abundant width, depth and a correct bite. Expression is outstanding with a small, correctly placed eye and tidy ears. His body is strong and muscular with good bone and substance, well angulated, muscular quarters and a deep chest. He moves confidently all directions of the ring.

Best of Opposite Sex

Cash, Wright and Schneider's **CH. GLENTOM LEBEOUF'S COUNTESS SINGING CLOUD** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance – Ch. Glentom Pearljam De Mint RN) A bright red and white with a lovely head with a gently curved and finished profile, sufficient depth, very good expression and a correct bite. She's beautifully constructed with a well arched neck, a clean angulated shoulder, uniformly angulated rear and a deep chest. Her bone and substance are proportionate for her size. She moves out well all ways of the ring.

Belstock's **CH. BELBAR DOUBLE CHOCOLATE CHIP** (Ch. Brummagem Chips Ahoy – Belbar Sinabar White Merlot)

Wright and Cournoyer's **CH. GLENTOM MINT COPY** (Ch. Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley – Ch. Glentom Mint Julep)

Winners Dog

Cox's **SOME OKIES KNIGHT OF D'BULL** (Ch. Nocturnal Knight At Arnolds – Biondi D'Rock And Bull) A handsome youngster with a long head completely turned and finished. Head on his expression is keen with a piercing eye and neat ears. His body is shapely with strong, round bone and loads of substance. His chest is deep and wide, topline strong and firm and his quarters are well muscled and angulated. I felt he moved better going away than coming in.

Reserve Winners Dog

Pew's **BULROARUS TUFF AT THE TOP** (Bulroarus Indina Jones – Buxston Last Noel) Another with a long head and smooth profile with good finish though I would prefer a bit more width viewed from the front. He also has very good bone with generous substance and well developed, strong quarters. Tends to show a bit of slackness behind the withers which is evident on the go-around. Otherwise a decent mover all directions of the ring.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex

Patterson and Wright's **GLENTOM RISING STAR** (Ch. Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley – Ch. Glentom Silver Lining) A very attractive, substantial girl with a classic head with requisite fill, finish and width. Her expression is spot-on with small, well set eyes well up on her head and neat ears. Bite is correct. Her body lines are curvaceous, bone is robust and sturdy. Her arched neck, correct length of back, deep chest and shapely shoulder and rear combine for a balanced silhouette. Moves typically all ways of the ring.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Croucher's **ACIE'S LINEN AND LACE** (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty – Acie's Dress To Thrill) Another lovely girl with an eye-catching profile with beautiful turn and fill. Would prefer a bit more muzzle width but expression is keen and penetrating. Her bite is just off from level. Her body is strong with considerable bone, a short back, sufficient substance and very shapely quarters. She too moves well up, back and in profile.

Best of Variety

Schneider and Wright's **CH. LEBEOUF BEAUCOUP BLANC OF GLENTOM** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance – Ch. Glentom Pearljam DeMint) A supremely masculine boy with a packed up head, a stunning profile and impressive width. Expression is penetrating with a tiny eye and ears set right on top. Bite is just off from level. His body is deep and strong with a short back, smooth, well angulated shoulder and rear and plenty of round bone. Standing he's seamlessly balanced and square. He moves effortlessly and typically all ways of the ring.
