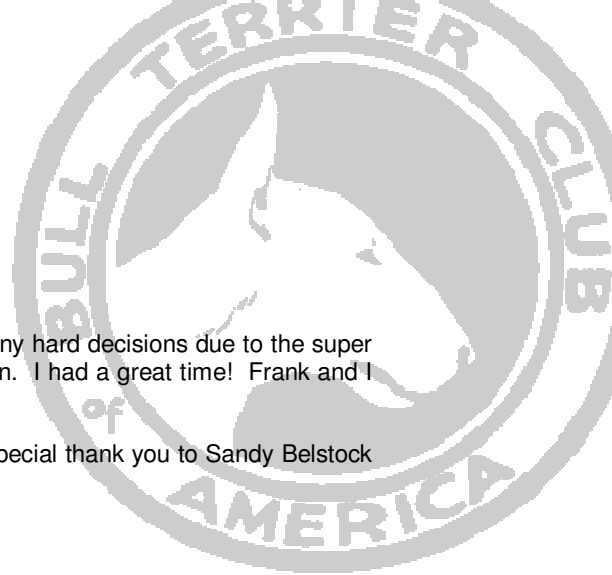


**Mile High Bull Terrier Club

Reserve Winners Dog

Azuer's **BULLY MANOR'S GLADIATOR** (Bully Manor's Centurion ex Ch. Butterfly Fields Angelica) Squarely build dog with large round bone. Turned head with plenty of fill right down to the end. Narrow dark eye. Excellent expression. Strong arched neck on a sturdy sound body. A free and easy mover with a super temperament.

Winners Dog, Best of Winners

Deever, Perrott and Hicks' **APPRENTICE SHOOTIN GUNNER MCGEE** (Apprentice's Ramblin Rowdy ex Ch. Apprentice's Shootin for Action) Large powerful dog. Striking profile – cranked and finished. Nice round muzzle. Bite correct. Plenty of underjaw. Masculine neck on a hearty, shapely body. Level topline. Good forechest and lay-back of shoulder. An extremely balanced mover. No coarseness here – an exceptional example of the breed.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Belstock, Frascone, and Niehouse's **BELBAR WILL O' THE WISP** (Ch. Sinabar Bellagio ex Ch. Belbar Desert Mahogany) Delightful beauty with a classic headpiece. Roman finish. Nice tight lips. Inscrutable eye and expression. Ample fill. Sweeping neck on a typy body. Well-let-down hocks. Active mover. Agility abounds on this sweet gal.

Winners Bitch

Larson and Hoare's **NIMROD BROWYN OF BETON** (Ch. Miramax Maximillion ex Beton Winsors Full House) Beautiful, elegant bitch. Outstanding head. Filled and turned. Correct mouth. The tiny eye makes for a wicked expression. Small strong ears. Long neck. Sound topline. Looks good both ways. Driving sidegait. Compact feet. Shiny, healthy coat. This lady enjoys being in the ring.

Best of Opposite Sex

Crouchers' **CH. ACIE'S JACK SPARROW** (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty ex Ch. Acies One More Look) Powerful dog with an excellent head. Cranked over with good length. Loads of fill. Correct mouth. Nice tight lips. Glinty eye – small and dark. Strong muscled neck on a sturdy body. Good spring of rib. Clean front. Driving rear – moves with plenty of reach and go. This happy, healty fellow was having lots of fun today.

Best of Variety

Wright and Cournoyer's **CH. GLENTOM MINT COPY** (Ch. Cool Conquistador at Crossgarley ex Ch. Glentom Mint Julep) Flashy, rich brindle beauty. All in one piece. Clean, sweeping profile of good length. Scissor bite. Sly eye – piercing expression. Graceful neck. Good shoulder assembly. Shapely body. Clean front. Strong rear angulation. Moves with a typical jaunty air. Presented in splendid condition. A real knock-out!

Reserve Winners Dog

Cox's **SOME OKIES KNIGHT OF D'BULL** (Ch. Nocturnal Knight at Arnolds ex Biondi D'Rock And Bull) Striking young dog. Extremely sturdy. Squarely built with large bone. Nicely turned head. Keen expression. Strong full muzzle. Clean, black lips. Muscled, arched neck. Sound honest body. Powerful moving – coming and going. Compact feet. Good covered coat. Nice shiny coat. Happy boy.

Winners Dog

Pew's **BULROARUS TUFF AT THE TOP** (Bulroarus Indina Jones – Buxston Last Noel) An excellent, good-sized white dog. Outstanding head, beautiful profile, filled and packed to the muzzle. Mouth correct. Tiny eye gives a very sneaky look. Strong ear leather. Level topline. Tail well set. Good front and rear. Superb movement, especially the side gait. A striking silhouette.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Crouchers' **ACIE'S LINEN AND LACE** (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty ex Acie's Dressed To Thrill) Outstanding bitch. Pretty with a sweeping profile. Bite correct. Beautiful expression. Sly, dark eye. Tight, black lips. Ears right on top. Sleek neck on a cobby body. Sound construction and in splendid condition, makes for an exceptional mover. A pleasure to go over her.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners

Davis' **D BAR'S SHE'S SO FOXY TULSADOOM** (Ch. Tulsadoom Chiyonofuji ex Ch. D Bar Classy Lady of Tulsadoom) Superb lady. Beautiful head, great turn and pack all the way to the end. Bite correct. Nice full muzzle with plenty of underjaw. Clean, white teeth. Uses her smart ears to perfection. Excellent topline. Tail set well (wags a lot). Looks good going away or coming towards. Compact cat feet. Glides about the ring. Excellent covered coat.

Best of Opposite Sex

Azuer's **CH. BULLY MANOR'S CENTURION** (Ch. Miramax Maximillion ex Bullover's Bailey Cream) Powerhouse dog with super bone. Strong profile with a sweeping roman finish. Packed to the tight, black lips. Level bite. Sinister expression. Well-placed ears. Muscled, shapely body. Moves with great reach and drive. This dashing guy was shown in rock hard condition.

Best of Variety

Patterson and Wright's **CH. GLENTOM'S RISING STAR** (Ch. Conquistator at Crossgarley ex Ch. Glentom Silver Lining) Sparkling young beauty with a striking profile. Cranked over, loads of fill. An unbroken curve. Wicked eye and look. Bite correct. Clean white teeth. Uses well-placed ears. Feminine arched neck on a strong cobby body. Just the right amount of bone. Moves well both ways due to balance. Beautiful sweeping side gait. A quality package with a great future.
