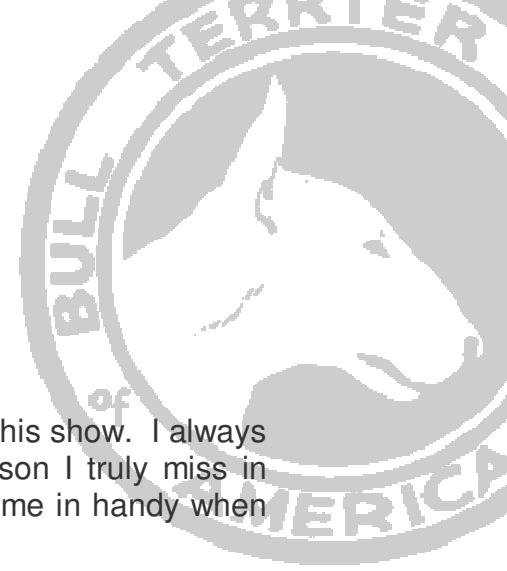

My appreciation to the exhibitors for the large entry with few absentees. Faulty dentition, wide ear sets and short length of upper arm continue to be prevalent problems. I also noticed a number of exhibits that could have benefited from oral hygiene.

#### COLOREDS 7-18- (2-4) 3 Absentees

##### Winners Dog & Best of Winners

Berez and Perrott's Action Head Games (Ch. Action Headed for Fame ex Ch. Dajan Classy Action) From the Bred By Exhibitor class, this is a tremendously powerful dog for his age. Very masculine head, filled right up with a beautiful profile. Mouth is correct. Tiny eyes and good ear set give him good expression. Good bone, good make and shape. Strong forechest with a straight front and very good bone. He has good rear angulation and tail set. His movement was clean. I would like a touch more length of upper arm and a shorter back. He just needs more time to mature and when this dog matures, he will be one to watch for.

##### Reserve Winners Dog

Frascone's Starstruck Firebreak (Starstruck Oberon ex Starstruck Colhartbitch) This is a large, substantial solid red dog. It was unfortunate for him to come up against the Winners Dog. His head is not as strong as the winner's. He has a good forechest, good bone for his size, a straight front and a good topline, but a little longer in back than the Winners Dog. He moved adequately.

##### Winners Bitch and Best of Opposite Sex

Ibtison and Cat's Baker St Black Butterfly (Ch. Baker St Back to Bonanza ex Baker St Bloom of the Rose). When this little, cobby solid black brindle bitch entered the ring, I thought, "OH, MY!" Beautiful and typey with a packed head and beautiful gently curved profile. Her mouth is reverse scissors with one tight canine. She could use a just pinch more underjaw. She has tiny eyes and a good ear set that give a beautiful expression. She is very well made. Her construction flows throughout with smooth body lines, a straight front, a good topline, a short back, good tail set and good rear angulation. She is well muscled and moved cleanly in both the front and rear.



#### Reserve Winners Bitch

Boznian's Bullayr's Moonshadow (Ch. Gwensyl It's Not Unusual ex Ch. Scarlet Moon The Joker) A black brindle bitch of a different type than the winner. This girl is elegant. She has a lovely head piece with nice fill, and a tiny eye and good ear set that give her a good expression. Her mouth is correct. She has beautiful reach of neck. Her front is straight with adequate bone. She is a little longer backed than the Winners Bitch and her movement is not as clean.

I would like to note that Sinabar Lyrical Passion, a six to nine month puppy bitch was also in consideration for one of these placements.

#### Best of Variety

Everett, Chorn, Frangos and Bankus' Ch. Crescent Silmaril Shadowfax (Ch. Boromir Quicksilver ex Ch. Silmaril Scarlet Temptress) This is an upstanding, well-matured tri-color male with very nice make and shape and good substance. His head has a gently curved profile with adequate fill

and good expression. His construction flows throughout with smooth body lines. His front is straight with a good forechest, I would like a bit more length of upper arm. He has good bone. The topline is correct and flows into a good tail set. He was pushed hard by the Winners Dog, but won on maturity and better substance.

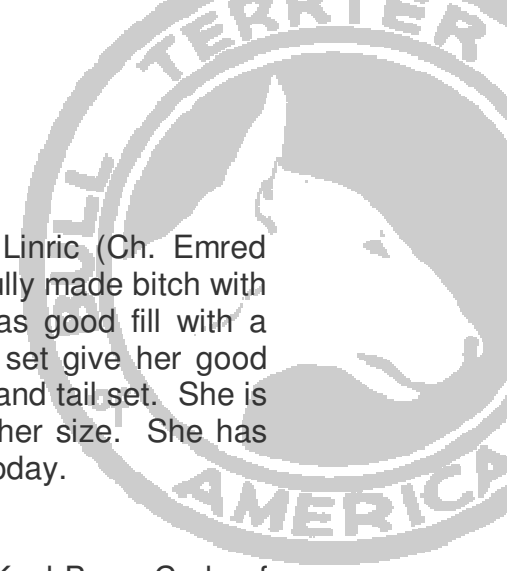
#### WHITES 4-10-(2-4)

##### Winners Dog

McGee and Lecki's Bedlam's Changing Times (Bedlam's Dashing Dude ex Ch. Bedlam's Sweet November) A chunky white male with good bone for his size. His head could utilize a touch more profile and fill. His mouth is under. His eye is small giving him good expression. His ear set could be tidier. His front is straight. The layback of shoulder could be better. He has a good topline and good rear angulation. His tail is set on a bit high. He was shorter coupled and moved better than his competition.

##### Reserve Winners Dog

Laker and Whitehair's Sandstone's Irish Gold (Terjo's The Vital Spark ex Mighty Bulls Beauty Brit) This white male does not have the profile or fill that the winner has. He lacks underjaw and his bite is under. He has a tiny eye, but wide set ears detract from his expression. He has a butterfly nose. He has clean body lines with a straight front and good rear angulation. He does not have the body substance of the winner.



#### Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex

Frascone and Jones-Ledesma's Sinabar Malibu Breeze at Linric (Ch. Emred Rum Runner ex Sinabar Adrenaline Infusion) This is a beautifully made bitch with very clean construction that flows throughout. Her head has good fill with a beautiful, gently curved profile. A tiny eye and a good ear set give her good expression. Her neck is reachy and flows into a good topline and tail set. She is a little long cast. Her front is straight with enough bone for her size. She has good rear angulation and was the best moving of the bitches today.

#### Reserve Winners Bitch

Stafford and Poole's Rocky Top's Simply Irresistable (Electo Kool Barra Cuda of Kilacabar ex Ch. Rocky Top's Honey 'N Rainbows) A heavyweight, substantial bitch with a beautiful gently curved profile and good fill. She has a correct bite. The eye is tiny with good expression, but she could use a tidier ear set. She has a good forechest and straight front, good topline, tail set and rear angulation. It was a close decision between this bitch and the winner, but this girl just did not want to show today.

#### Best of Variety

Altmann and Berez's Ch. Action Dream Come True (Ch. Old Forge Tug McGraw at Chevalier ex Ch. Action Moonbeam Dream) This boy lives up to his name and is a tremendous powerhouse of a dog even though he is not an overly large dog. He has a heavy, masculine head with plenty of fill and a gently curved profile, but has a short length of foreface. Good underjaw and a correct mouth. Tiny, varminty eyes and good ear set give him beautiful expression. The body lines are clean and his front is straight with good depth of forechest. The undercarriage is clean. He has a good topline and tail set. The rear angulation is good. He was one of the better movers on the day. He is well muscled and conditioned. He was an easy winner on the day.
