Cobby well made brindle and white. Good breed type with style and symmetry. A strong head with decent profile, excellent expression with well sunken eyes. Mouth correct. Good bone, strength of forechest, body nicely rounded with strong short loin. Moved out with confidence.

#15 Glentom Simon Says (Ch. Glentom's Bruce Almighty - Ch. Glentom The Sneak Preview) Owners Glenna Wright and Robert and Mary Alice Edwards.

Quality red brindle, longer cast than the winners dog. Good head with lovely curving profile from the side. Mouth fault. Strength in the front and rear, moved out well.

Colored Bitches

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, and Best of Variety

#24 Banbury Bedrock But Whoz Yr Daddy (Ch. Gothic's the Kingmaker - Ch. Banbury Bedrock Barchetta) RN OA OAJ MXP3 MJP3. Owners Mary Remer and W.E. Mackay Smith

Compact brindle and white young bitch. Clean proportions and good balance. Feminine lovely head, very smooth profile with fill and keen eye, mouth correct with clean well placed teeth and strength in the underjaw. Short backed and in good balance her front and rear movement were true.

Reserve Winners Bitch

#20 Bulpen's Devil in the Details (Ann-Dee's Bar None - Bulpen- Browyn Boc's Legacy) Owners Beth and Jeff Parry and Gayle Hall.

Competitive tricolor with arresting profile, good dark eye and well held ears lending breed expression. Powerful brisket, level topline and correct croup. Correct mouth. A useful girl.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

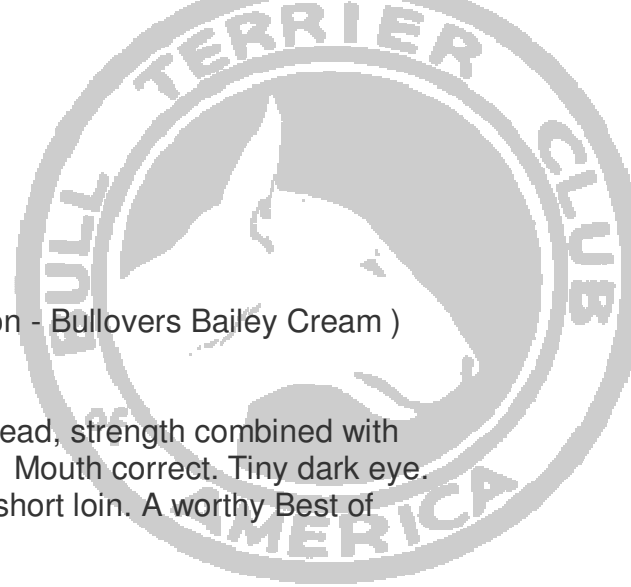

Stylish white bitch with red brindle head marking. Very pleasing proportions, broad chest from the front, good strong shoulders, firm topline and well made rear. Her head demonstrated desired breed type with good eye placement set off by tidy ears. Mouth fault.

Typey bitch with a good head, with profile and fill and keen expression. Mouth fault. Good bone, pleasing balanced body proportions with a shorter loin. She moved out well.



Best of Variety

21 Ch. Bully Manors Centurion (Ch. Miramax Maximillion - Bullovers Bailey Cream)
Owner, Phyllis Azeur

Eye catching white dog with strong breed virtue. Lovely head, strength combined with quality, excellent curving profile, good depth of underjaw. Mouth correct. Tiny dark eye. Muscular neck, good shoulder layback and level topline, short loin. A worthy Best of Variety and I enjoyed watching him in the Group ring.

Best Opposite Sex

#16 Ch. Action Pure Class (Ch Bestuvall Razor Redi Cut - Ch Dajan Classy Action)

Quality bitch with lovely headpiece sweeping profile, with fill, and correct mouth. Well arched clean neck, good shoulder. Balanced body proportions, and strongly made rear, she pushed hard for BOV.
