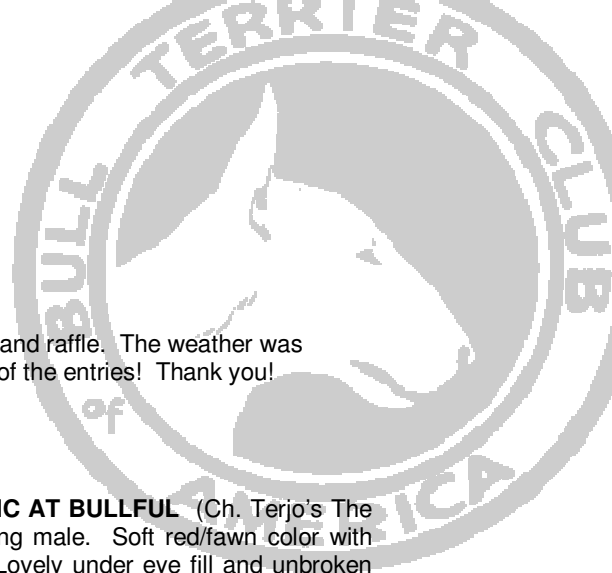


**BTC of Philadelphia

## **COLORED**

### **Winners Dog, Best of Winners**

Bishop, Fournier-Fike and Flke's **CABEN SUNDANCE TO THE MUSE-IC AT BULLFUL** (Ch. Terjo's The Vital Spark, ROM ex Ch. Paradoz Muse-ic To My Ears, ROM) A young male. Soft red/fawn color with attractive white markings. Great depth to muzzle and curve of head. Lovely under eye fill and unbroken curve from occiput to nose. Well shaped, dark eyes. Bite correct. Outstanding expression. Correct front assembly. In overall body proportion, he seems a little low on leg and a tiny bit long in loin. Was not overly confident in the ring, but that apparently was largely due to an unfamiliar handler. Two days later, I saw him show again and he was stacking beautifully and showing himself off very nicely. He moves well and purposefully. I was told later, he is a Rufus grandson and especially in head, he has a strong resemblance to his grandsire.

### **Reserve Winners Bitch**

Martins' **GOTHIC'S MASQUERADE AT BULPIN** (Lodina Iced Image ex Ch. Gothics Black Dahlia) A pretty, well marked red and white bitch with touches of smut markings. Attractive head and expression. Good fill and depth of muzzle. Dark eyes. Under. Clean lines. Moves well, but tends to stack and move with a gay tail that disrupts an otherwise nice outline. Despite carriage, tail set seems correct.

### **Winners Bitch**

Bozian's **BULLAYR MOONSHADOW** (Ch. Gwynsel Its Not Unusual ex Ch. Scartlet Moon the Joker) I had some very nice choices in bitches, particularly in the Bred-By class. This black brindle girl is extremely attractive, especially in profile. Good depth of muzzle, lovely curve of head, slightly under, nice ear set. Clean, correct front, with good angles front and rear. Nice tight feet. Slightly long cast and stacking for any length of time, she tends to go slack and show a slight sag in her topline. She seems an easy-going bitch, who doesn't feel the need to show with flash and style. Moves well, with a bounciness that tends to break the topline.. She is however, classy, well made overall, with very good bone and substance.

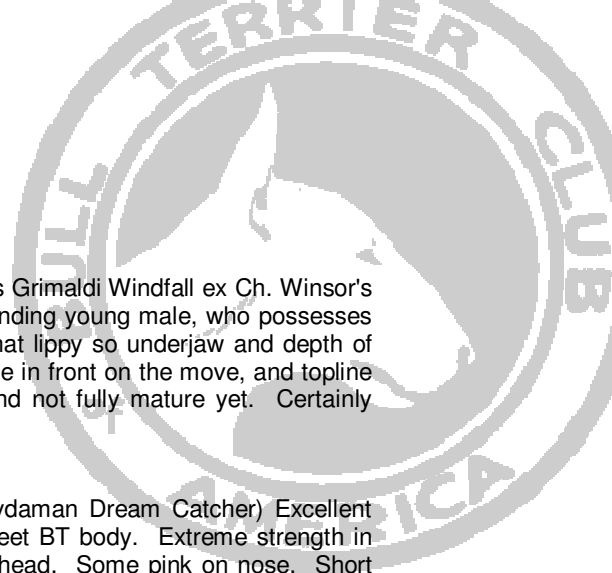
### **Best Of Opposite**

Cash, Wright and Schneider's **CH. GLENTOM LEBOEUF'S COUNTESS SINGING CLOUD** (Ch. Dazlin Defiance ex Ch. Glentom Pearljam De Mint, RN) Well made red bitch with generous white markings on head, back and legs and some smut markings on her muzzle. Good head quality that would be improved with a bit more fill and ears more on top of her head. Well made with very good bone and substance. Moves better going than coming. On the move, shows a gay tail that settles in stacking.

### **Best Of Variety**

Wright's **CH. GLENTOM SIMON SAYS** (Ch. Glentom Bruce Almighty ex Ch. Glentom The Sneak Preview) Handsome brindle & white male. Strongly masculine head and body. Excellent classic male BT expression with very good fill. Slightly under. Dark eyes. Correct eye shape and placement. Tight feet. Clean front, strong neck with good arch. Slightly long in loin. Moves very well with especially good reach. Holds his topline on the move. Very good bone and substance.

## WHITE

### Reserve Winners Dog

Wilson's **LEGACY HUGHES YOUR DADDY OF WINSOR** (Ch. Victoria's Grimaldi Windfall ex Ch. Winsor's Hope Springs Eternal) From the Bred By class, he is a powerful, upstanding young male, who possesses good length of head and has good fill with strength of profile. Somewhat lippy so underjaw and depth of muzzle seem compromised. Somewhat lanky in body build. A little loose in front on the move, and topline breaks slightly on the move. Good bone and substance. Youthful and not fully mature yet. Certainly promising.

### Winners Dog, Best of Winners

Martin and Morden's **RHYDAMAN FROSTY** (Emred Huntsman ex Rhydaman Dream Catcher) Excellent bone and substance. Very masculine. The essence of power in a sweet BT body. Extreme strength in head. Dark, correct eyes, very good under eye fill, excellent length of head. Some pink on nose. Short backed with good proportions. A heavy weight with solid make & shape. To be fussy I'd like to see a little strength in and upright positioning of pasterns, but he otherwise stacks nicely and moves well, with good drive.

### Reserve Winners Bitch

Wright's **GLENTOM EVENING STAR** (Ch. Cool Conquistador At Crossgarley ex Ch. Glentom Silver Lining) A very different type from my WB, but both are lovely. More upstanding than WB. On the move, does not hold her topline terribly well. Holds her tail very gaily and creates a less balanced picture than WB. Very nice expression, lacking a bit in fill, she seems like a very promising youngster.

### Winners Bitch

Ibbitsons' **BAKER ST BRASS BONANZA OF ARAGON-RUFFIN** (Ch. Baker St Back to Bonanza ex Ch. Horizon's Harmony of Aragon) Compact, cobby bitch, who bounced into the ring, seemingly thrilled with *every thing* in her life. Her expression is pure feminine BT mischief maker. Good depth of muzzle, tiny, dark alert, eyes. Slightly under. A little more length of leg would give her better overall proportion. Slight browning of the coat, may well be diet related. She stacks herself well and shows a solid topline and correct tailset. Good strength of quarters. She came into the ring ready to win and share her sunny spirit. Her infectious personality is obvious and engaging. At Silverwood, I watched her become a finalist.

### Best Of Opposite

McGee's **CH. BEDLAM'S CHANGING TIMES** (Bedlam's Dashing Dude ex Ch. Bedlam's Sweet November) Handsome male who has a solid clean front, neat feet, and good depth of chest. He is a tad long in back and the rise over loin is a little more than *slight*, but acceptable. Eyes are more almond than triangular and ears could be a bit more up on his head. Despite those small debits, he possesses a good quality head. Overall, he is a very attractive package. Moves well.

### Best Of Variety

Idone and Berez's **CH. ACTION CHAOS I'M SO DELICIOUS** (Ch. Brummagen Chips Ahoy, ROM ex Ch. Action Chaos and Charisma, ROM) Compact, very well made bitch. Long feminine head, with dark, beautiful eyes and lovely expression. Could use a touch more fill. Well placed and sized ears. Very slightly under. Moved very well. By virtue of her sounder construction, she narrowly beat out the bitch to whom, I gave Select Bitch. Both are outstanding white bitches and deciding between the two was my longest and most difficult decision of the day. This bitch went on to a group 4 placement in one of the toughest Terrier shows of the year.
