

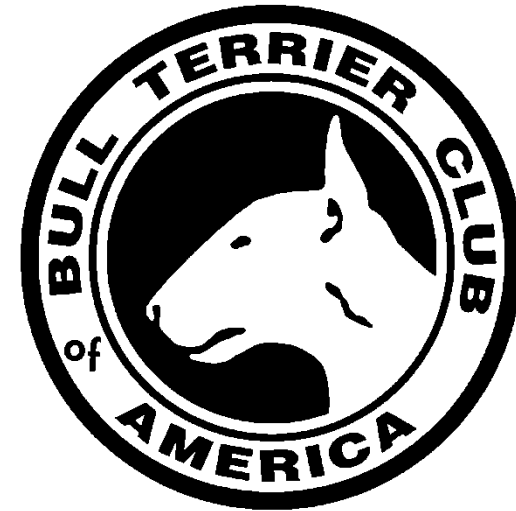

After the BOV, BOW & BOS competition is completed, the judge may give Awards of Merit to the remaining dogs & bitches (up to 10%) that completed the BOV competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class-For stud dogs and a minimum of 2, or maximum of 3 of their get. The stud dog MUST be entered in the class and shown in the ring with the get. The Owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. The get MUST be entered in a regular class, best of breed competition or some other non-regular class. The class will be judged on the merits of the get.

Brood Bitch Class-Is the same as for the stud dog class, except substitute "brood bitch" for "stud dog" and "produce" for "get".

Brace Class-Is two dogs which have at least one common owner. Requires a fee of \$15.00 for the unit. The dogs comprising a brace class must be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a brace class, is not entered in another class, it MUST be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes-"Brace Class". If more than one brace is entered by identical ownership, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated "brace No. 1", "brace No. 2", etc.

Best Of Breed

Breeder Class Special Attraction

ELIGIBILITY: A multiple entry class consisting of 3-5 dogs of the same breed. All dogs must have at least one breeder in common who must be present to accept the award. The individual dogs comprising the entry must be from at least two different combinations of parents, but need not be owned or handled by the breeder. Each individual dog must be handled by its own handler. Each dog must be entered individually in a regular class. The entry fee for the Breeders class will be \$5.00 and submitted by the breeder who is entering the class. One entry fee for each breeder. A dog may not be entered for two different breeders entries. The entry form is available in this document.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Novice Class- For boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class- For boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitutions must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular confirmation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of First Place in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by the AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive Suite 100 Raleigh, NC 27617-3390 e-mail: info@akc.org.

NOTICE: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

A RECORDING FEE OF 50 CENTS will be required for each dog entered at any Obedience Trial, Licensed or Member Club Show. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. See AKC rules chapter 14, section 2.

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 12 Noon EDT, WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2011 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, changed or substituted except as provided for in the AKC Dog Show Rules chapter 14, section 6.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the show committee or cancellation of win by the American Kennel Club. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

ENTRIES NOT ON AN OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FROM or photocopies of the form WITHOUT the agreement and rules on the reverse side will NOT be accepted. Entries without the fees are not acceptable. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire, act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club or its secretary.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS MUST BE RECEIVED in writing prior to the closing of entries. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable.

ERRORS ON ENTRIES: Owners are responsible for any errors on entry forms, no matter who filled out the entry form or made the error. No entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. Returned checks do NOT constitute a valid entry.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. They will adhere to the judging schedule as closely as possible. Owners and Agents are fully responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring at the appropriate time. The show giving club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system, stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

DOGS NEED ONLY BE PRESENT for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
