COLORED

Winners Dog

Cathcart's JARROGUE'S SIDEKICK (CH Tawnbarr Shooting Star ex Jarroque's Hellcat) A black brindle and white that catches your eye immediately when he enters the ring. Unfortunately he and his handler struggled with the surroundings and who was in charge, making him difficult to assess. A cracking powerhouse of a dog with super turn of head, ears right on top, eyes triangular, deep-set and well placed. Long foreface that is completely fill with bone. Mouth is correct. Plenty of bone and substance with a lot of body volume. Good reach of neck into a solid shoulder and topline. Nice short back and good angles to the hind quarters and plenty of second thigh. I was only able to get a fleeting glimpse of his movement, he moves square and true with authority and plenty of horsepower. This was my hardest decision on the day, wanting to put him up all the way, yet knowing he is not ready for the spotlight. If and when he figures this all out he will compete at the highest level.

Reserve Winners Dog

DeGidio and Bronson's JOCKO'S SHOW GUN (CH Triumph Jocko's Kid Bullets @ Jackannette's ex Rasel's Bull Voice Of The Heart) A brindle with a well turned head. Nice expression and fill, mouth is ok. Strong thick neck with good reach, an upright shoulder makes him a little long cast in the back. Good bone and substance, moved proportionately for his construction.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Boley and Myall's TWYLITE'S DEVILS LITTLE SISTER (GCH CH Hawthorn Dragons Heart ex CH Twylite Return to Sender) A brindle and white with a beautifully turned head, nice expression, length of foreface and fill under the eye. Nice reach of neck into a solid topline and a short back. Enough bone for her size, well up on her toes yielding a nice typey outline. Moved straight in front and with plenty of drive in the rear. Won on her better body type and front on expression.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Aten's STONEHOUSE'S BAD BETTY'S A STAR (CH Tawnbarr Shooting Star ex CH Notorious Miesha Tate) A black brindle with enough turn to her head with good fill. Eye placement needs to be higher. Good reach of neck into a solid topline. Good bone and substance for her size. Not as compact as the winner, moved well both ways.

Best of Breed and Best Owner Handled

Thomas's GCH GRABO SYMPATHY FOR THE DEVIL MOON (Rabram Rock Star ex Grabo Bahama Moon)

A brindle and white with an attitude to boot not placing a foot wrong on the day. A turned head with small triangular eyes that are well placed and deep-set. Plenty of fill under the eye with good length of foreface. Mouth is correct. Strong thick neck, would like a tad more reach, good shoulder and topline and tailset. Good bone and substance and with plenty of body volume. His conditioning is top flight. Well up on his pasterns with tight cat feet. Nice angulation to his hind quarters. Moved well both ways.

Best of Opposite Sex

Harlamoff, Draper, Boyda and Ruppell's GCH BAYSHORE SWEARS LIKE A SAILOR IN SOQUEL (CH Unfailing Ocean View ex Quicksilver Song of the Sea at Soquel) A brindle and white with a long sweeping turned head, ears right on top, good expression and eye placement. Good length of foreface with plenty of fill under the eye. Mouth is correct. Good reach of neck, nice shoulder, topline and tailset. I would like to see more compact. Excellent bone and substance and tight feet. Front is straight, elbows tucked, she moved with ease around the ring. Exceptional hind quarters with all the correct angles, moved well and drove effortlessly going away.

Select Dog

Thomas's GCH CH GRABO TESTAROSSA FORMULA FOR DRAMA (GCHCH Action's Devils Apprentice By Formula ex GCHCH Action's Formula For A Queen) A red and white dog with a broad top skull and ears right on top. Well placed eyes that are dark and triangular. Good fill under the eye with good length of foreface and Roman finish. Incisors are level, one tight canine and good strength of under jaw. Strong thick neck flowing into a solid shoulder and topline. Very good bone all the way into his pasterns and good cat feet. Plenty of depth of brisket and body volume with this dog. He could afford to lose a couple pounds to have a better tuck up in the loin. Fully mature, he still moves with good reach, moving squarely coming towards and plenty of drive going away.

Select Bitch

Frawley, Decker and Baval's GCH OLD ENGLAND'S HAPPILY EVER AFTER (GCH CH Hawthorn Dragon Heart ex GCHCH Old England's Notso Basic Biotch). A brindle and white with a super turned head, good fill under the eye with good expression. Nice length of foreface, mouth is correct. Good reach of neck and solid topline. I would like her a little more compact. Has enough bone for her size. Nice straight front along with tight feet. Good angulation to the hind quarters, moved well both ways.

WHITE

Winners Dog

Shaw's SECOND2NONE KING OF COOL (CH Apex Presents The Italian Stallion at Action ex CH Second2None Crown Jewel) All white with a strong powerful head, eyes deep, well placed with good expression. Proper length of foreface and fill under the eye. Mouth is good. A young dog with super bone and substance. Okay reach of neck into a strong shoulder, wish he had a shorter back. Moved well both ways.

Reserve Winners Dog

Pierini's BESTUVALL FIVE STAR General (CH Bestuvall Old Spice ex CH Action Formula For A Primadrama) A white with a well turned head, eyes deeply sunken and well placed with good expression. Proper length of foreface and okay fill under the eye. Incisors are correct, one canine is tight. Would like more reach of neck. Enough bone and substance for his size. Movement was square and clean coming towards, okay going away. An easy reserve.

Winners Bitch and Best of Winners

Bebb's SUNNY SKY ST GEORGE SHE'S A GOOD GIRL (CH Lonestar Whole Lota Hoopla ex St George Sugar Sugar) White with a beautifully turned head, good expression and proper length of foreface. I would like a little more fill under the eye. Mouth is just off. Her outline catches you when she enters the ring. Good reach of neck into a nice shoulder and short back. A very typey body, good bone for her frame. Good straight front with nice angles in the hindquarters. Moved very well both ways.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Shaw and Camplotti's SECOND2NONE CROWN ROYAL (GCHCH Kingsfarm Dutch Royal ex GCHCH Second2None Crown Jewel) Nice girl with a turned head, good expression and fill under the eye. Mouth is just off. Good reach of neck, solid shoulder and topline. Relatively short back. Super bone and substance which she excels at over the Winner. I like this bitch a lot, just lacks the balance and shape of the winner. Moved well both ways. Tough day to run against the Winner.

Best of Breed and Best Owner Handled

Bebb and McPeter's GCH CH SUNNY SKY ST GEORGE KEEP DRIVING (CH Lonestar Whole Lota Hoopla ex St George Sugar Sugar) This girl had it all today. Nicely turned head with ears right on top. Small triangular eyes that are deepset and placed well. Good fill under the eye and length of foreface. Mouth is correct. Long reachy neck into a nice shoulder and top line. She possesses a nice short back, enhancing her outline from the side. Enough bone for her size with good rib spring. Nice straight front and square hindquarters, she moves truly coming towards and going away. A pleasure to award her the top prize. It was fun to know after the show that my BOV and WB are littermates, lots of similarities between them, this is what dog shows are supposed to be about.

Best of Opposite Sex

Cremeans and Leonard's GCHB CH RASELS BULL AC DC BCAT ATT FITB (Rasels Bull Ivan ex Rasels Bull True) A white with a lot of depth and scope to him, a nicely turned head with good expression and fill with good length of foreface. Mouth is just off, canines are correct. Nice reach of neck, strong shoulder and a solid topline. Enough bone for his size, I would prefer tighter feet. Moved well both ways.

Select Dog

Taeu, Antle and Dykema's GCH SIERRA VIEW BESTUVALL IN THE CROSSHAIRS (Bestuvall Old Spice ex GCHB CH Bestuvall Cross My Heart) A masculine dog with a strong head, just not the turn or fill of my Best of Opposite. Good expression, a strong thick neck with enough reach, solid shoulder and topline. I would like him shorter in back. Good bone and substance, tight feet and moved well both ways.

Select Bitch

Cremeans, Evans and Leonard's CH GALACTIC BITTERSWEET LEGACY AT IRUKANDJI (Mighty Crew Irukandji ex Galactic Double Star) An all white with a well turned head, nice expression with small triangular deep-set eyes. Good length of foreface with plenty of fill under the eyes. Mouth is off. Shows herself to the fullest, nice reach of neck into a good shoulder and straight front, solid topline, beautiful bone with plenty of substance to her. Slightly long cast, nice angles to her hind quarters, moved appropriately both ways.
