**COLORED, 2-4 (3-3)**

**Winners Dog**

Brenda Ugoretz, Larry Lemke & Paul O'Driscoll, **HAWTHORN CALL ME MR. BIG AT TUFFNUTZ** (Emred Devils Spy- Hawthorn Black Currant Stout) Well-marked brindle and white male with a powerful head, showing plenty of turn and a pleasing Roman finish. His bite is incorrect, and his ears are set wide and far back on the skull. He has a strong neck that flows into a short back with a good tail set. While his overall structure is solid, he would benefit from more bend of stifle to improve rear balance.

**Reserve Winners Dog**

Antonio Coleman, **TARGARYEN RED** (Hawthorn Dragons Heart - Neala) Red and white male with kind eyes and a moderate head. He has a correct bite, though more fill under the eyes would enhance his expression. His ears are set wide. He has a short back with a correct tail set, and moderate angulation both front and rear.

**Winners Bitch and Best of Winners**

Paul O'Driscoll, **HAWTHORN BLOODY MARY** (Tawnbarr Devils Eye From Gorbain - Hawthorn Shirley Temple) Red and white bitch with a beautifully turned, long, and well-filled head that shows strength without exaggeration. Her bite is incorrect, and her ears are set wide. She has a good length of neck that flows smoothly into a strong topline, with a correct tail set. Her front is straight with nice bone and correct feet, and she shows good rear angulation. Improved shoulder construction would enhance her overall balance. Well presented.

**Reserve Winners Bitch**

Brenda Ugoretz, Larry Lemke & Paul O'Driscoll, **HAWTHORN I'M SO HAPPY AT TUFFNUTZ** (Emred Devils Spy - Hawthorn Black Currant Stout) Brindle and white bitch with a nicely turned and filled head. Her ears are set wide, and her bite is incorrect. She has a good length of neck, though she is slightly upright in shoulder, which results in a minor dip behind the withers. Her back is of moderate length with a correct tail set, and she shows moderate rear angulation.

**Best of Variety**

Laura J Anderson, and Paul O'Driscoll, **CH HAWTHORN KILLIAN'S IRISH RED** (Tawnbarr Devils Eye From Gorbain - Hawthorn Shirley Temple) Typey, well-marked red and white male with a beautifully powerful, well-filled head that is nicely turned and of good length. His ears are set wide. He has a strong neck that flows into a short back, with a correct tail set and a nice spring of rib. Bone is adequate for his size. He shows balanced, though moderate, front and rear angulation and moved freely through the ring.

### **Best of Opposite Sex**

Lori Kibler, Rebecca P Poole & William F Poole, **CH ROCKY TOP'S CHERISH YOUR DREAM** (Hawthorn Dragons Heart - Rocky Top's Sweetest Dream) Solid dark brindle bitch with a powerful, well-packed head and a correct profile. She has a correct bite, though her ears are set wide. Her strong neck flows into a correct topline and appropriate length of back, with a well-set tail. She has a straight front with correct angulation, which contributes to a nicely developed, deep forechest. Rear angulation is also correct. She has good bone and tidy feet and was very well presented.

### **Select Dog**

Lori Kibler, Rebecca P Poole & William F Poole, **GCHS CH ROCKY TOP'S DREAM CHASER** (Hawthorn Dragons Heart - Rocky Top's Sweetest Dream) Typey brindle and white male with a powerful, well-filled head, showing a nice turn and Roman finish. He has correctly shaped eyes, a correct bite, and wide-set ears. His neck appears a bit stuffy, which affects his overall outline. He has a correct tail set and moderate front and rear angulation, which gives him a slightly longer appearance in the back. I would have liked to see him a bit more animated in the ring. Well presented.

### **Select Bitch**

Lori Kibler, Rebecca P Poole & William F Poole, **CH ROCKY TOP'S DARE TO DREAM** (Hawthorn Dragons Heart - Rocky Top's Sweetest Dream) Solid brindle bitch with a nicely shaped head and a good profile. She would benefit from a bit more fill under the eyes. Her bite is correct, and her ears are set wide. She has a strong neck that flows into a moderately long back with a correct tail set. She is slightly short in upper arm, which contributes to a bull front. Rear angulation is moderate. Well presented.

## **WHITE, 2-3 (3-3)**

### **Winners Dog**

Young April & Miranda Carter, **BULPAK REBEL BEAR BOP FYB** (Bulpak Polar Bear-D-City Dark Freedom) White male with a fawn ear marking and a well-filled, substantial head. He has deep-set eyes with a good expression, though his bite is incorrect and his ears are set wide. He elbows out slightly and has a short upper arm, which limits his forechest development. His topline is acceptable, with a correct tail set. He has moderate bone for his size and neat, cat-like feet.

### **Reserve Winners Dog**

Antonio Coleman, **THE PERFECT STORM** (Hawthorn Dragons Heart - Neala) White male with a moderate head that would benefit from more fill under the eyes to achieve a more correct, egg-shaped profile. He has kind eyes and a well-pigmented nose. Bite is correct, and ear set is acceptable. His back is of moderate length, with balanced front and rear angulation. He would benefit from stronger pasterns to improve overall support and movement.

### **Winners Bitch & Best of Winners**

Ginny Wendland, **CASTLEREA'S LONG NIGHT MOON** (Brookbully Avenger - AÁucar Castleresa de Canisgrowth) Typey white bitch with a beautiful head, showing excellent fill and correctly shaped eyes that give her a piercing expression. Her head is smoothly turned with a pleasing Roman finish. Bite is incorrect, and her ears could be better set higher on the head. She has a good length of neck, though she dips slightly behind the withers. Tail set is high, and she would benefit from more bend of stifle to improve rear balance.

### **Reserve Winners**

Cleo Parker, **NUANCE NOW OR NEVER RATI RATM CGC** (Bullymoon Stands For Liberty With Sandstone - Nuance Next Big Thing) White bitch with an eye patch and a moderate head that

would benefit from more fill under the eyes. She has a correct bite and wide-set ears. Her neck is of correct length and flows smoothly into a good topline. She shows good front and rear angulation and moved freely around the ring.

#### **Best of Variety**

Alesia & Russell Cooke, **GCH CH LECHMERE HIDDEN SECRETS** (Super Bowl's Amadeo-Lechmere Baby Sister) Substantial, powerful white male with a masculine head and a good expression. He has a correct bite and maintains a nice topline on the move. His front and rear angulation are well balanced, and he possesses excellent bone that carries all the way down through his pasterns. He has tidy feet, moved well in both directions, and was very well presented.

#### **Best of Opposite Sex**

Anna Cremeans, Jackson Leonard, Beth Evans, **GCHS CH GALACTIC BITTERSWEET LEGACY AT IRUKANDJI C.** (Mighty crew irukandji-Galactic double star) Powerful white bitch with a beautifully turned and well-filled head. Her bite is incorrect, and her ears are set wide. She has a strong neck, though her back is slightly long. She shows great spring of rib, good bone, and a nicely developed fore chest. Rear angulation is acceptable. Overall, a well-constructed bitch with presence.

#### **Select Dog**

Elise and Scott McHatton & Kim Bebb, **CH SUNNY SKY ST GEORGE CANYON MOON** (Lonestar Whole Lotta Hoopla-St George Sugar Sugar) White male with a moderate head, featuring a smooth profile and a correct Roman finish. He would benefit from more fill under the eyes to achieve a more classic egg-shaped appearance. He has a strong neck that flows into a correct topline and a well-set tail. While he has moderate front and rear angulation, a slightly broader chest would improve his overall balance. He has good bone for his size, tidy feet, and was well presented.

#### **Select Bitch**

Patricia Murphy, **GCH CH BALLY'S WINTER WINNER CHICKEN** (Bally's Squiggy Wheel Gets the Grease - Bally's Jezebel of the Ball) Typey, feminine white female with a distinctive earmark. She has a smooth profile and a well-proportioned head of good length. Could use a bit more fill under the eyes. Correct bite. Very nice expression. Good length of neck that flows smoothly into a correct topline and tail set. Short, strong back. Front angulation could be improved; rear angulation is acceptable. Very well presented.
