Winners Dog and Best of Winners

Cathcart's **JARROGUE'S SIDEKICK** (CH Tawnbarr Shooting Star ex Jarrogue's Hellcat) Eye-catching black brindle and white boy. Headpiece is well turned and very well filled with pronounced Roman finish. Good length of neck, short back, decent lay of shoulder. Nice round bone and good body volume. When he settled down, he moved well, especially in front. Had he been better behaved, he would have pushed hard for BOV.

Reserve Winners Dog

Bronsons, Kart and DeGidio's **JOCKO'S SHOW GUN** (Jocko's Kid Bullets @Jackannette's ex Rasels Bull Voice Of The Heart) A brindle boy, who was unlucky to run into the WD today. Head is turned and moderately filled. Strongly muscled neck into a somewhat upright shoulder, making him appear longcast. Nice bone, plenty of substance. Moves as made, a bit retracted in front, but drives strongly behind.

Winners Bitch

Aten's **STONEHOUSE'S BAD BETTY'S A STAR** (CH Tawnbarr's Shooting Star ex CH Notorious Miesha Tate) Petite black brindle and white youngster. Head has no exaggeration anywhere, but has enough turn and moderate fill. Her debit is her eye is set a bit low on the head, which somewhat affects her expression. However, she has a lovely length of neck, which flows cleanly into a short back and solid topline. In outline, she is square and cleanly made. Her movement was the best on the day – reaching out well in front and driving well behind. In beautiful, hard condition.

Reserve Winners Bitch and Best Bred By Exhibitor

Boley and Myall's **TWYLITE'S DEVILS LITTLE SISTER** (GCHB Hawthorn Dragon's Heart ex CH Twylite Return To Sender) Very Nice youngster also, this one with nice turn to her head with good fill and nice expression. Enough length of neck into a solid topline. Enough bone and good substance. Moves well both ways.

Best of Variety and Best Owner Handled

Antle and Dykema's **GCHS SIERRA VIEW BESTUVALL CROSS INTO COOL** (GCHS Grabo Testarossa Formula For Drama ex GCHB Bestuvall Cross My Heart) Well-known brindle and white, who shows her socks off. Good size and in impeccable condition. Head has lovely turn and is filled right up. Really nice expression for a colored. Good reach of neck into a muscular topline. Good bone for size and type. Lots of ribspring and body volume. Moves beautifully in front, a tiny bit close behind – but drives well with good flexion. A very deserving winner.

Best of Opposite Sex

Harlamoff, Draper, Waynee and Martin's **GCH SOQUEL MILLENIUM BLACK SEAS** (Unfailing Ocean View ex CH Soquel Millenium Black Pearl) Black brindle and white boy, who caught my eye with his beautiful layback of shoulder – which, unfortunately, is all too unusual these days. Head is masculine, although not fancy – he has adequate turn and good fill, nice eye placement and neat ears. Nice length of neck into a short, muscular topline with exactly the right amount of shape/rise over the loin. Correct tailset!!! Heavy bone for size with great width and depth to his brisket. Moved well all ways.

Select Dog

Brand, Dykema and Antle's **CH SIERRA VIEW BESTUVALL CROSS THE FINISH LINE** ((GCHS Grabo Testarossa Formula For Drama ex GCHB Bestuvall Cross My Heart) Similar to my BOV, I later found they are littermates. Good size masculine dog. Pleasing head, could use a smidgeon more neck, good topline. Moderate angulation at both ends, he moved well all ways.

Select Bitch

Frawley, Decker and Baval's **GCH OLD ENGLAND'S HAPPILY EVER AFTER** (GCH Hawthorn Dragons Heart ex GCH Old England's Not So Basic Biotch) Good size brindle and white. Super turned head with good fill and nice expression. Nice reach of neck. Would like a bit more shapely topline. Nice bone and substance, she moved well coming and going.

Award of Merit

Bebb's **CH ST GEORGE SUNNY SKY SHE'S THE ONE** (CH Lonestar Whole Lota Hoopla ex St George Sugar Sugar)

Winners Dog

Shaw's **SECOND2NONE KING OF COOL** (CH Apex Presents The Italian Stallion at Action ex CH Second2None Crown Jewel) Big masculine puppy. Head is nicely turned, moderately filled. He has tiny eyes and neat ears. Heavy bone and nice body volume for one so young. No exaggeration anywhere, he is nicely proportioned and moves soundly.

Reserve Winners Dog

Shaw and Dykema's **BESTUVALL PACKIN HEAT AT SECOND2NONE** (Quicksilver Wanted Man ex Bestuvall's Hot Little Pistol) Nice white boy, not as mature as the Winner. Pleasing head with good length of foreface, nice expression. Good bone for size. Needs a bit more time to mature.

Winners Bitch, Best of Winners and Best Bred By Exhibitor

Bebb's **SUNNY SKY ST GEORGE SHE'S A GOOD GIRL** (CH Lonestar Whole Lota Hoopla ex St George Sugar Sugar) Lovely white bitch with a pretty, feminine head with nice expression and neat ears. Nice length of neck into a solid topline. Good proportion and balance; moderate angles at both ends. Similar to my BOV, but not as mature or as square.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Glenn and Gothan's **GLENN'S PEARL OF BULLARDS** (GCHS Soquel Millenium High Seas ex Lavish N Bullards Country Storm) Just a baby (6 months old), but a pretty one. Head handles well, with nice turn and decent fill, neat ears. Nice length of neck into a solid topline, giving her a balanced outline. Enough bone for size and style, moderate ribspring and body volume. Moves squarely, with animation all ways. Promising puppy.

Best of Variety and Best Owner Handled

McPeters and Bebb's **GCH SUNNY SKY ST GEORGE KEEP DRIVING** (CH Lonestar Whole Lota Hoopla ex St George Sugar Sugar) Lovely, well-proportioned white bitch. Head is long and filled with lovely turn. Ears are set well. Eyes are small and obliquely set yielding varminty expression. Lovely long neck into a solid, shapely topline and correct tailset. Nice round bone, nice substance for a youngster. Neat feet. Moves well all ways – side movement and silhouette are particularly nice. An easy Best of Variety in a strong specials class.

Best of Opposite Sex

Antle and Dykema's **GCHS KINGS FARM'S DUTCH ROYAL** (Teirwgwyn Top Gun ex CH Action Hot and Classy) This is a large framed boy. No exaggeration anywhere, just a good honest dog. Head is large and masculine, with moderate turn and fill, nice expression. Good length of neck into a solid topline. Lovely round bone and good body volume. A bit long cast. Moves smoothly and soundly all ways of the ring.

Select Dog

Cremeans and Leonard's **GCHB RASELS BULL AC DC BCAT ATT FITB** (Rasels Bull Elvis ex Rasels Bull True) A typey boy. Head is filled and moderately turned. A bit short in foreface. Very masculine through the body with good round bone, a thick neck and substantial body. Short backed. Moves fairly well both ways.

Select Bitch

Cremeans, Evans and Leonard's **GCH GALACTIC BITTERSWEET LEGACY AT IRUKANDJI CGC TKN FDC BCAT** (Mighty Crew Irukandji ex Galactic Double Star) Lovely white girl with a cracking headpiece with good fill and expression, nice turn and strong underjaw. Good length of neck into a topline that was a bit soft behind the withers today. Decent shoulder, front and nice rear angulation. She moved well in front, a bit closely behind.
