COLORED

Winners Dog, Best of Winners and Best of Variety

Champion, Deevers and Perrott's **APPRENTICE DANCIN WITH THE DEVIL** (GCH Formula for a Drama Free Brother CGC TKA VSW1 ex GCH Apprentice's Gandy Dancin TKN) A young boy, only nineteen months of age. Beautiful red brindle with nice white markings. His head is large, nicely filled and turned and very masculine. Nice length of neck into a very short back. Good angulation in the rear, shoulder could be a bit more laid back, but that's being really picky. Tremendous bone and substance, good ribspring for his age. Gorgeous tight cat feet. Moved well all ways, clean in front and with good flexion behind. A very deserving dog. I was told later in the day that this was his first show weekend – he has a promising future indeed.

Reserve Winners Dog

Dowdy and Gran's **ACTION DIVINE SUN KISSED** (GCH Formula for a Drama Free Brother ex GCH Action Kissed by the Divine from Old Forge) Another young dog, this one was unlucky to run into my winner today. Head has good length and width, although his facial markings are distracting. Moderately turned and filled. Good dentition. Balanced length of neck and length of back. Has yet to spring his rib, but has good substance for his age. Lovely round bone and straight front, he moved well all ways of the ring.

Winners Bitch and Best of Opposite Sex

Hess, Searles and Corse's **REQUIEM KAPTIVATING IN KHROME** (CH Patterned Head Bull Boot ex CH Khromeheart Corsaire from Provokacija) Mature and feminine brindle and white bitch. She has a long, smoothly filled and nicely turned head, lovely neck and solid topline. Decent layback of shoulder into a firm topline with very good ribspring and substance. She is a bit longcast but carries it well, holding her topline on the move and while stacked. Moves as made, moving out smoothly and confidently.

Reserve Winners Bitch

Deevers, Perrott and Migliore's **APPRENTICE TAP DANCIN SHOES** (CH Action Headed for Fame ex GCH Apprentice's Gandy Dancin TKN) Solid brindle youngster of very good type. Head is long and gently turned with moderate fill and squinty little eyes. Her debit is her earset, which hampered her expression. She has good balance height/length with a nice straight front and decent hind angulation. She moves well, although a bit puppy loose at the moment.

Select Dog

Searles and Corse' **GCH REQUIEM STAY KHROME PONYBOY ATT** (CH Patterned Head Bull Boot ex CH Khromeheart Corsaire from Provokacija) A well-known brindle and white. He is a large, masculine boy with a massive turned and well-filled head. Bite correct. Wicked eyes and neat ears, which he used to advantage. Very nice bone for size and with moderate angles at both ends, a bit long cast but with ample ribspring and body volume. He moves well all ways, if a tad close behind.

Select Bitch

Glaser and Lindquist's **GCH MADCAP TILABOO SILK PAJAMAS** (CH Patterned Head Bull Boot ex CH Madcap Tilaboo Joy's Advocate) A lovely, feminine red and white. Long, sweeping head with moderate fill and neat ears. Nice length of neck into a solid topline. Decent shoulders and shapely topline. Could use more bone. Moves well in front and a bit closely behind.

Award of Merit

Morrison, Deevers, Perrott and Migliore's **CH APPRENTICE PAINTIN THE TOWN RED TKN** (GCH Formula for a Drama Free Brother ex GCH Apprentice's Gandy Dancin) A heavyweight fawn and white. Nice wide head with moderate turn. Eye could be smaller, but placed well. Neat ears. Lovely straight front with neat feet. Decent shoulder, topline and rear angulation. A bit overweight on the day (and not moving as well as she is capable of moving) dropped her down a placement.

WHITE

Winners Bitch

Clayton's **SORABULLYS DOUBLE DOWN ON SUSHI POPS** (CH Sorabully's Suchi's Ichiban ex Sorabully's You Had Me at Konichiwa) A young white bitch with brindle headmarkings. This one has attitude to spare and has the perfect amount of Bull Terrier sass. Head is well filled and moderately turned – nice strength of underjaw and good bite. Strongly muscled neck into a solid topline. Well spring ribs for her age and stage of development. She has bone and substance to spare. Moved smoothly and with reach and drive, never letting down.

Reserve Winners Bitch

McClamrock and Deevers' **APPRENTICE DANCIN THE CHA CHA** (CH Action Headed for Fame ex GCH Apprentice's Gandy Dancin) Nicely presented white puppy bitch, who needs time to mature. Head is long and a bit narrow at the moment, but with lovely turn and expression, good bite. Beautiful straight front and well muscled read. She is a bit long in loin and has not yet sprung her rib, but a promising puppy who enjoyed her outing.

Best of Variety

Armstrong and Sottile's **GCH ALARIC STAR SPANGLED SISTER** (GCHS Malajo's Formula For a Drama Devil ex CH Alaric Wish Upon a Star) Aptly named, this gorgeous white

bitch was definitely the star of the show today. Head is long and deep, well filled and with great eye placement. Small, neat ears and good bite. Underjaw is deep and broad. Muscular neck into a solid shoulder placement with good layback and a lovely short back with just the right amount of rise over the loin. Excellent depth of brisket. Best tailset on the day. Well angulated both front and rear, she reached out well in front and drove nicely behind. This is a wonderful example of our beloved breed and it was my pleasure to award her the top spot today.

Best of Opposite Sex

Smith and Cox' **GCHB SOME OKIES HOT CLASSY LEGEND OF DEVILS SPY** (CH Kingsfarm Hot Classy Devil ex Some Okie's Wicked Witch) Well-presented white male. Head is a lovely long arc and with very nice eye shape and placement. Nice length of neck into a well proportioned body. Appeared a bit thin on the day. Nice make and shape, he moved well all ways. I especially like his beautiful outline.

Select Bitch

Searles and Corse' **CH REQUIEM CORSAIRE ALL THAT GLITTERS IS KHROME** (CH Patterned Head Bull Boot ex CH Khromeheart Corsaire from Provokacija) Good size white girl, a brood bitch type. Lovely long head with good fill and nice eye placement. Good length of neck into a strongly muscled topline. Could be a bit shorter in loin. Moderate angulation both front and rear. Good bone for size and great body volume. Moved cleanly in front and a bit closely behind but with good drive.
